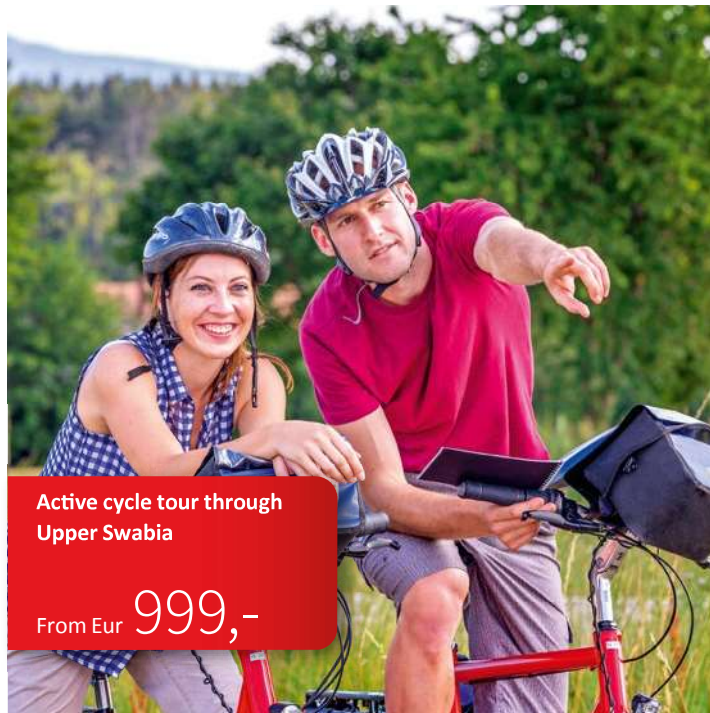

Your tour

On this tour, you cycle through three different landscapes: You cycle around the lower lake, the maybe most beautiful section of the Lake Constance with the cities Constance, Stein am Rhein and the Rhine falls in Schaffhausen. You follow the Danube cycle path through young Danube valley, that is framed by impressive rocks. And you cycle through the slightly hilly Allgäu, with its lush green meadows and breathtaking alpine panoramas.

Day 5	Fridingen – Scheer / Sigmaringen, approx. 40 – 55 km
Day 6	Sigmaringen – Bad Waldsee, approx. 60 / 50 km
Day 7	Bad Waldsee – Wangen im Allgäu, approx. 50 km
Day 8	Wangen – Constance, approx. 50 km + catamaran trip

Journey to Konstanz

→ Closest airport: Zurich, Stuttgart, Basel, Karlsruhe, Memmingen, Friedrichshafen

→ Train station: Constance

Parking in Konstanz

→ Fenced parking lot near the Radweg-Reisen office in Constance, must be booked and paid in advance.

→ Parking garages (Fischmarkt, Dammgasse, Lago, Altstadt, Benediktinerplatz), costs approx. 25 Euro / day

→ Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents)

Bike handover

→ Pick-up at Radweg-Reisen in Konstanz between 9 am and 7 pm, 7 days per week. On request delivery to the hotel, then no individual adjustment by our staff on site. Departure: Return at Radweg-Reisen or guests leave them at the hotel.

Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

→ 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

→ Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Constance

Take the opportunity to visit the island of Mainau, wander through Constance's old town or visit the aquariums in the Sea Life Center and go to the Archaeological Museum.

Day 2: Constance – Schaffhausen, approx. 50 km

Following the side of Lake Constance, you pedal to Stein am Rhein with its frescoed, medieval houses. Switching several times between Germany and Switzerland you reach the canton's capital, Schaffhausen. The town, whose citizens competed with each other in building gables on their houses, is overlooked by Munot fort.

Day 3: Schaffhausen – Rhine Falls – Radolfzell, approx. 50 km

After a good breakfast you cycle to the Rhine Falls, only about 5 km downstream from Schaffhausen. You can get right up close to them on a boat – an unforgettable experience! Then follow the Rhine upstream back to Stein am Rhein. From there you cycle along the Höri peninsula, which was home to Hermann Hesse and Otto Dix for a time, to Radolfzell. Enjoy the views over to Reichenau island and the Hegau volcanoes!

Day 4: Radolfzell – Mühlheim / Fridingen, approx. 45 km + train ride or approx. 70 km

You now turn your back on the lake and cycle past Langenstein Castle and the Aach spring, whose water mostly comes from the Danube. You are heading for Engen. We can recommend a train ride from here to Tuttlingen in order to avoid the incline involving some 500 metres of altitude. Along the Danube you roll - seemingly without effort - to Mühlheim and Fridingen.

Day 5: Fridingen – Scheer / Sigmaringen, approx. 40 – 55 km

The chalkstone rocks rise some 100 metres above the cycle path which snakes its way through the rocks here, following the river. You will keep seeing an old castle on the rocks above or rather what remains of it. In Sigmaringen there's another magnificent castle to be discovered, Hohenzollern Castle is still lived in by a noble family and you can go an interesting guided tour if you like.

Day 6: Sigmaringen – Bad Waldsee, approx. 60 / 50 km

Along the Danube you cycle to Hundersingen, where it's worth visiting the open air museum of Heuneburg. From here you head south for the Upper Swabian spa area with its many thermal springs. Today's destination is Bad Waldsee, mud spa and Kneipp spa resort with a Spätzle (German noodle) museum, where you can learn all about this favourite local dish.

Day 7: Bad Waldsee – Wangen im Allgäu, approx. 50 km

Today, you leave Upper Swabian for Allgäu and arrive in Wolfegg, where you can visit the extensive farmhouse museum. Via Kisslegg, you cycle on to Wangen in Allgäu with unspoiled city towers, many fountains and Baroque-style pub signs.

Day 8: Wangen – Constance, approx. 50 km + catamaran trip

You cycle along the Danube-Lake Constance-cycle path today, through the Tett nang hops area, the most southern hopsgrowing area in Germany. Pedaling through orchards, you cycle to Kressbronn, where you find yourself back on Lake Constance. Following the Lake Constance cycle path, your tour takes you finally to Friedrichshafen, where you hop on to a catamaran to be returned to Constance.

Day 9: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
