Your tour

On this tour, that is easy to cycle, you discover the Franconian Zealand and the upper reaches of the Altmühl in a relaxed way. Dive into the water of the Brombach and the Altmühl lake, follow the traces of the Romans in Weißenburg and take a look from the castle Pappenheim into the valley. We have put many services in this tour and chosen the stages in such a way, that also kids come at their expenses.

Journey to Gunzenhausen

→ Closest airports: Nuremberg→ Train station: Gunzenhausen

Parking in Gunzenhausen

- → There are public parking spaces available near the hotel, free of charge. It is not possible to reserve.
- → Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

→ Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.

Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- → 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- → Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Gunzenhausen

Your trip begins right in the middle of the Franconian Lake District, a popular holiday region. This is where the Roman border Limes used to be. In the town you'll still see traces of the Roman Empire. Gunzenhausen is the only Bavarian town that is right on the Limes.

Day 2: Round tour Brombachsee lake, approx. 35 km + boat trip

Along the cycle path to Lake Brombach, today's destination, there are many playgrounds. But don't stay too long, as the lake truly caters to all tastes: beach volleyball, playgrounds, beach, beer garden - everything you could possibly wish for at Brombachsee Lake. A special adventure is a trip on Europe's biggest passenger trimaran - with a restaurant and a children's boat on deck.

Day 3: Gunzenhausen - Weißenburg, approx. 40 km

Today, you cycle pleasantly along quiet paths through woods, fields and meadows. From Pleinfeld, you cycle along the Swabian Rezat towards Weissenburg with its historic old town and exciting Imperial city sights. Follow the tracks of the Romans and explore the historic quarter.

Day 4: Weißenburg - Wettelsheim, approx. 30 km

Today, the Swabian Rezat accompanies you to the Altmühl which you then follow to Pappenheim Castle. From the castle you have fantastic views over the Altmühl valley, through which you then cycle to get to today's destination of Treuchtlingen or Wettelsheim. In the evening, relax in the Altmühl thermal baths.

Day 5: Wettelsheim – Gunzenhausen and round tour Altmühlsee lake, approx. 40 km

The last section is a very easy cycle along a pleasantly level path. Once you have arrived in Gunzenhausen, you should not waste any time in setting off on a circular tour of the Altmühlsee Lake. Enjoy a dip in this large, shallow reservoir. Water sports people and sunbathers are in for a treat.

Day 6: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
