Your tour

Do you have nine days and desire for a bit more challenging bike tour? But still want to have time to see sights like the fairytale castle Neuschwanstein? And also want to glide with the mountain railway over the numerous summits? Then start a roundtrip from Lindau through the Allgäu! You follow the cycle paths like from a picture book through the idyllic foothills of the Alps and get to know Bavaria's most beautiful side.

Journey to Lindau

- Closest airports: Zurich, Friedrichshafen, Stuttgart, Basel, Memmingen, München
- Train station: Lindau-Insel, Lindau-Reutin

Parking in Lindau

- Karl-Bever-Platz (P3, 311 parking spaces) and Seeparkplatz (P5, 660 parking spaces), costs: approx. 10 € per day. No reservation possible.

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Lindau

Your tour begins on Lake Constance in Lindau, whose beautiful old town is on an island. Discover the windy little streets and explore the famous harbour entrance complete with lighthouse and a 6 metre-high Bavarian lion, backdropped by a magnificent panorama of the Alps.

Day 2: Lindau – Oberstaufen, approx. 55 km

You cycle briefly along the lakeside but soon leave Lake Constance to cycle along the Bodensee Königssee cycle path up to the Allgäu hills. You pass luscious meadows with happily munching cows to Oberstaufen, just as one imagines the Allgäu should be. In the show dairy, you can find out how they make their delicious cheese and even try some.

Day 3: Oberstaufen – Nesselwang, approx. 50 km

The section begins along even ground and takes you through the valley of the Konstanzer Ach river to the Großer Alpsee Lake. From there you head to Immenstadt passing the foothills of the Grünten, also known as the Allgäu's watchman. You cycle a while along Rottachsee Lake and at Oy-Mittelberg, have reached the highest point of the tour. From here it's not long to this section's destination, Nesselwang.

Day 4: Nesselwang – Füssen / Schwangau, approx. 25 / 60 km

The distance today is quite short, because at the Forggensee lake great sights await you: Neuschwanstein Castle and its „little sister“, Hohenschwangau Castle! You should not miss those impressive fairy tale castles! Our tip: It is best to book your tickets in advance. If you would rather cycle a longer distance, you can circle the Forggensee.

Day 5: Füssen – Kempten, approx. 70 km

Along Forggensee, Germany's biggest reservoir and the steam train circular, you cycle to Marktoberdorf. From there you cycle through Kempten Forest, encountering a number of inclines before you arrive in Kempten. Today's destination, Kempten, was founded by the Romans as the town of Cambodunum, and is one of the oldest towns in Germany. A guided tour of the staterooms of the residence is worth it - which include profane and sacred elements.

Day 6: Kempten – Wangen / Allgäu, approx. 65 km

You cycle along a disused railway track in the Württemberg part of the Allgäu, up to the European watershed of the Rhine and the Danube. Take a break in Isny, a town on the Upper Swabian Baroque route - always worth a visit, before cycling along the Danube-Lake Constance cycle path to Wangen.

Day 7: Wangen – Lindau, approx. 45 km

You cycle along the Danube-Lake Constance-cycle path today, through the Tettnang hops area, the most southern hopsgrowing area in Germany. Through orchards you cycle to Kressbronn where you are back at Lake Constance and follow them Lake Constance cycle path the last few kilometres back to Lindau.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
