Your tour

This leisurely cycling tour along the Bavarian Danube takes you right across the Free State of Bavaria. Along the way, you will discover historic yet wonderfully diverse towns and repeatedly immerse yourself in unspoilt natural landscapes. Your route takes you to Ingolstadt, where the Bavarian Beer Purity Law was proclaimed in 1516. Further east, you will visit the impressive Danube Gorge near Weltenburg before reaching the Gothic city of Regensburg with its magnificent old town. The grand finale of your cycling holiday along the Bavarian Danube is Passau, the Three Rivers City, where the Inn, Ilz and Danube rivers meet. Throughout the journey, there is plenty of time to enjoy the breathtaking scenery and let the beauty of the Bavarian landscape unfold before you.

- Return journey to Donauwörth: Optional with return transfer, duration approx. 2.5–3 hours, price on request, must be booked in advance.
- On your own by train, connections approx. every hour, 1 - 2 changes, duration approx. 3 - 5 hours.

Parking in Donauwörth / Wörnitzstein

- Public car park „Im Ried“, costs approx. 5 EUR / day.
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).
- Free public parking in Wörnitzstein, approx. 600 m from the starting hotel

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- From the 2027 season onwards, travel documents will be provided in digital format as standard. These include a navigation app, GPS tracks and a digital route book. Printed route books are available on request for a supplement of €20 per copy.
- The digital travel documents will be sent by email approximately one month before the start of the tour. Luggage tags as well as any required printed admission tickets and travel tickets will be available at the first hotel upon arrival.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Donauwörth / Wörnitzstein

Your tour begins in the lovely town of Donauwörth, where the formerly important trading path between Nuremberg and Augsburg crossed the Danube. Splendid town houses remind us even today of the significance and riches this town once enjoyed.

Day 2: Donauwörth – Ingolstadt, approx. 65 km

You cycle along well-established paths through the foothills of the Franconian Alb to Neuburg, where we can recommend taking a stroll through the charming old town or a visit to the castle, towering magnificently over the town. Today's destination is Ingolstadt with its old fortifications. It is also where the Bavarian Purity Law for beer was passed over 500 years ago.

Day 3: Ingolstadt – Kelheim, approx. 35 – 60 km + boat trip

You cycle through Danube meadowland, almost entirely right alongside the river, to Bad Gögging. Mother Nature has a special treat in store a little further on - the Danube Gap at Weltenburg Monastery, where the Danube curves its way through massive Jura rocks. Fortify yourself in the monastery beer garden before catching your boat, which takes you through the Gap to Kelheim. Alternatively you will stay overnight in Abensberg and take the boat trip on the following day.

Day 4: Abensberg – Regensburg, approx. 60 km + boat trip

Along the Abens and then the Danube you cycle to the Weltenburg monastery, where a very special natural spectacle awaits you: the Danube breakthrough, where the Danube has carved its way through a massive Jura rock. But be sure to fortify yourself in the monastery's beer garden before taking a boat through the Danube breakthrough to Kelheim and from there on to Regensburg.

Day 5: Regensburg – Straubing, approx. 55 km

The Danube curves its way gracefully through the wide expanse of the countryside and you cycle alongside. Take a short break at Walhalla, which King Ludwig I had built, before setting off for today's destination at Straubing, the capital of the „Gäuboden“ region. Every year in summer, the popular Gäubodenfest is celebrated here.

Day 6: Straubing – Deggendorf, approx. 40 km

Your cycling adventure continues as you make your way to the charming little town of Bogen. Visit the pilgrimage church of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary on Bogenberg Hill and take in the stunning views across the Danube before continuing via Pfelling and Mariaposching to your destination for the day: Deggendorf. Known as the gateway to the Bavarian Forest, this vibrant town invites you to discover its unique character. Treat yourself to Deggendorf's famous dumplings for a well-deserved refreshment and explore the historic old town with its charming town square and the Old Town Hall.

Day 7: Deggendorf – Passau, approx. 55 km

Today marks the final stretch of your journey! Your destination, the three-river city of Passau, is the perfect place to bring your cycling tour along the Bavarian Danube to a memorable close. With a long and fascinating history, the city's heritage can be felt around every corner. A leisurely stroll through Passau will allow you to enjoy its almost Mediterranean atmosphere and unique charm. Be sure to visit St. Stephen's Cathedral and the Veste Oberhaus fortress, majestically located above the Danube.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
