## Your tour

Cycling and boating on the Danube from Passau to Budapest is certainly one of the classics among cycling tours. And rightly so! Your journey begins in the three-river city of Passau. You will cycle through the Schlögener Donauschlinge and the Wachau World Heritage Site on the Danube Cycle Path, which is flat throughout. In addition, the Danube metropolises of Vienna, Bratislava and Budapest await you. Since the ship often sails in the evening or at night, you have enough time for the activities during the day and can enjoy a stress-free vacation.

## **Stages description**

#### Day 1: Individual arrival in Passau, Passau - Engelhartszell (boat)

You start the great cruise on the Danube by bike and ship in the three-river city of Passau, where the Danube, Inn and Ilz flow together. Arrive early enough to marvel at the worlds largest church organ in St. Stephans Cathedral and take a stroll through the charming old town. You can check in on the ship until 16.00 and it's time to cast off as early as 17.00!

## Day 2: Engelhartszell – Aschach, approx. 40 km, Aschach – Devin (boat)

Off on your bike! Before turning your back on Engelhartszell, take a short detour to Engelszell Abbey, the only Trappist monastery in Austria. Continue on to the Donauschlinge near Schlögen. From one of the lookout points you can observe the Danube turning 180 degrees quite wonderfully. Only a few kilometers away you will reach Aschach. Stretch your legs a bit with a stroll through the historic town center before heading to Bratislava overnight in the afternoon. Day 3: Devin – Bratislava, approx. 45 km, Bratislava – Budapest (boat)

The next stage by bike takes you from Devin to the lively metropolis of Bratislava the next day. Experience the unique atmosphere of the Slovakian capital on a tour of the city. The very next morning you will reach Budapest by ship.

## Day 4: Rest day or excursion to Szentendre, approx. 55 km, Budapest – Donauknie (boat)

Already the entry into the operetta city of Budapest is an experience, as many sights can be seen from on board. Take your time to explore the Hungarian capital. A nice alternative is a bike trip to the enchanting artists' town of Szentendre. In the evening we recommend a city tour by bus through the illuminated Budapest. A special highlight is also the folklore show you can watch. Immerse yourself in Hungarian traditions with music, dances and regional delicacies.

## Day 5: Donauknie – Esztergom, approx. 45 km, Esztergom – Vienna (boat)

Today you will cycle through picturesque and gently rolling landscapes, which are typical for the Hungarian Wachau. Experience real Hungarian joie de vivre and Puszta romance on this bike tour. Esztergom is one of the oldest cities and former capital of Hungary. It is also home to the largest classical basilica in the country, perched high on the castle hill.

## Day 6: Rest day in Vienna, Vienna – Wachau (boat)

Today the ship stays in place until the evening, so you can explore the Austrian capital at your own leisure. Discover the idyllic old town with its many historic buildings and monuments as well as beautiful squares and lovingly restored houses. Indulge your palate with delicious specialities in one of the many traditional coffee houses before returning to the ship. In the late evening, you will sail overnight in the Wachau to Dürnstein or Rossatz.

## Day 7: Wachau / Krems – Melk, approx. 40 km, Melk – Passau (boat)

After leaving Vienna yesterday evening, you will reach the Wachau in the early morning with the small town of Krems. The landscape of the Wachau is characterized by wine terraces, castles and monasteries simply wonderful! Stop in a Heurigen in the village of Spitz and taste different wines (not included). Following the course of the Danube, you will reach Melk. Already from a distance you can see the Melk Abbey. The Benedictine abbey is considered the landmark of the Wachau and impresses with one of the most beautiful baroque ensembles in Europe. In the afternoon, your ship sets off on its way back to Passau.

## Day 8: Individual departure from Passau

After you reach Passau at around 10.00 a.m., your Danube cruise already ends. Disembarkation starts at around 10.30 am. You will start your individual journey home.
