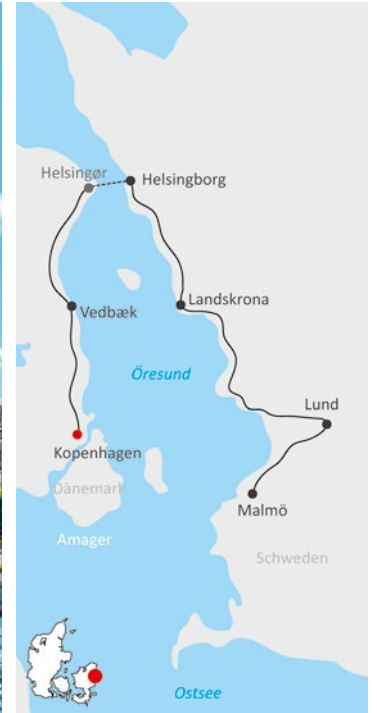

Your tour

The tour connects the coasts of the Danish island of Zealand and the Swedish province of Skåne. Along the Øresund you cycle along breathtaking coasts, through lively harbour towns and enjoy the typical Danish-Swedish serenity. From cosmopolitan Copenhagen you start on a cycling tour that takes you through charming landscapes and to numerous sights such as Kronberg Slot, Lund Cathedral and the Turning Torso in Malmö. Don't forget your swimsuit: On the way, sandy beaches offer sunny and refreshing moments!

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Copenhagen

Velkommen til København! As one of the oldest capitals in the world, the city impresses with a perfect mix of historical ambience and modern cosmopolitanism. A perfect place to start your bike tour on Aeland! After checking in at the hotel, grab your bike and explore the city centre. The royal Amalienborg Palace, the nostalgic amusement park Tivoli, the magnificent Rosenborg Slot with the Crown Jewels or the alternative free city Christiania – the earlier you arrive, the better, there is a lot to see!

Day 2: Copenhagen – Vedbæk region, approx. 25 km

Heading north, you start the first stage of your bike tour along the Øresund. A first stop is just beyond the city limits of Copenhagen. Bellevue beach with its long jetties is ideal for taking a dip in the crystal-clear waters of the Øresund. With a view of the strait and the

sea breeze in your luggage, you cycle through Jægersborg Dyrehave. The game park impresses with its large population of roe deer, old oaks and the Eremitageslottet hunting lodge.

Day 3: Vedbæk – Helsingborg, approx. 25 km + Ferry ride

Enjoy the drive along the Øresund coast with magnificent views of the sea. A longer stopover is worthwhile at the Louisiana Museum in Humlebæk. It is considered one of the worlds most important museums for modern and contemporary art. Located directly on the Øresund, it presents works by famous international and Danish artists. In Helsingør, visit the impressive Kronborg Slot. It became world-famous as the setting for Shakespeares Hamlet. Take the ferry to Helsingborg in Sweden.

Day 4: Helsingborg – Landskrona, approx. 30 km

Before you set off on the third stage of your bike tour along the Øresund, take a walk through Helsingborg. The city has Sweden's second largest harbour. The square brick tower Kärnan is located near the harbour. It dominates the silhouette of the city. From the roof platform of the tower you have a wonderful view over the city and the Øresund. You cycle along the Swedish coast to your destination for the day, Landskrona. The town's landmark is the former citadel made of red brickwork.

Day 5: Landskrona – Lund, approx. 50 km

If you have some time left in Landskrona, take a ferry trip to the island of Ven. The famous astronomer Tycho Brahe once conducted research on Ven. There is a museum dedicated to him. Leaving Landskrona behind, follow the cycle path along the coast. Head inland to reach the university town of Lund. Visit the medieval town centre and Lund

Cathedral. Sweden's oldest and most important cathedral has an architecture that is unusual for Scandinavia. The astronomical clock at the entrance portal of the cathedral is striking.

Day 6: Lund – Malmö, approx. 25 km

The last stage of your bike tour along Øresund takes you back to the sea. Relax on the white sandy beach of Lomma Beach and enjoy the view of Copenhagen opposite and the Øresund Bridge. In your destination Malmö, the Turning Torso is considered the city's new landmark. The futuristic residential tower is the tallest building in Scandinavia. The nearby old town presents itself with historical buildings worth seeing, colourful half-timbered houses, small shops and cosy restaurants.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
