Your tour

This trip takes you through the breathtaking landscapes of northern England. After arriving in Newcastle upon Tyne, your journey begins in Whitehaven on the Irish Sea, where you will embark on the C2C cycle route that takes you through the majestic Lake District with its rugged mountains, rolling valleys, and sparkling lakes. The route continues over the rolling hills of the Pennines, which offer an unforgettable backdrop with their vast grasslands and mystical moors. After a detour to the North Sea, the journey, which includes some steep climbs, leads back to the starting point in Newcastle upon Tyne.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Newcastle

Welcome to England's northernmost city! The former mining and industrial city of Newcastle upon Tyne is the starting point for your cycling holiday in England. This lively student city is a melting pot of modernity and over a thousand years of history. Newcastle's highlights include the architecturally impressive Tyne bridges, Newcastle Castle, and Grainger Town, the historic heart of the city.

Day 2: Whitehaven - Threlkeld ca. 60 km + Transfer

After breakfast, you will receive your rental bikes (if booked) and some travel documents at your hotel. A transfer will take you to Whitehaven on the English west coast, on the Irish Sea. At the harbor there, you will start the first stage of your cycling holiday in England on the Coast to Coast Cycle Route. You will cycle on quiet country roads up to Whinlatter Pass, a mountain pass. You will descend to Keswick on Derwentwater, England's fourth largest lake. Before reaching your overnight stop in Threlkeld, you will make a stop at Castlerigg Stone Circle, one of the largest stone circles in England.

Day 3: Threlkeld - Edenhall ca. 40 km

The route now takes you along quiet, traffic-free country roads through rolling hills dotted with small farms. The next highlight is the historic Greystoke Castle, which is said to have inspired the legend of Tarzan. The route then takes you through the charming town of Penrith. Shortly after, you will reach your accommodation in the idyllic village of Edenhall, where you can end the day in a relaxed atmosphere.

Day 4: Edenhall - Alston ca. 35 km

Today, a challenging stage with some elevation gain awaits you. Once you reach Hartside Pass, you can enjoy a well-deserved break and take in the impressive views of the surrounding landscape and the Solway

Firth – all the way to Scotland. Then it's back on your bike and down to Alston. England's highest market town is located in the north of the Pennines, a low mountain range considered one of the most beautiful landscapes in Great Britain.

Day 5: Alston - Blanchland ca. 35 km

Today's stage tackles the trip's highest and hilliest terrain. After passing the old mining village of Nenthead, you climb to Black Hill (609 m), the route's highest point. Continue via Killhope Top to Allenheads, England's highest village, home to the quirky Allenheads Inn. After a few more miles, reach Rookhope, then ride quiet lanes across the wild North Pennines to your accommodation in picturesque Blanchland. For an extra challenge, you can extend the route via Stanhope and Crawleyside Bank, adding about 13 km and 250 m of ascent.

Day 6: Blanchland - Tynemouth - Newcastle ca. 80 km + Transfer

The last stage of your cycling holiday in England takes you to the North Sea coast. You follow an easy route that takes you over several bridges and railway viaducts. You reach the town of Gateshead. Marvel at the Blinking Eye bascule bridge before crossing the River Tyne to Newcastle. Following the Tyne, you will arrive in Tynemouth. Take a deep breath of the salty North Sea air on one of the town's beaches. You will be transferred back to Newcastle (included).

Day 7: Individual departure Newcastle

After breakfast, your cycling holiday in England on the Coast to Coast Cycle Route comes to an end.
