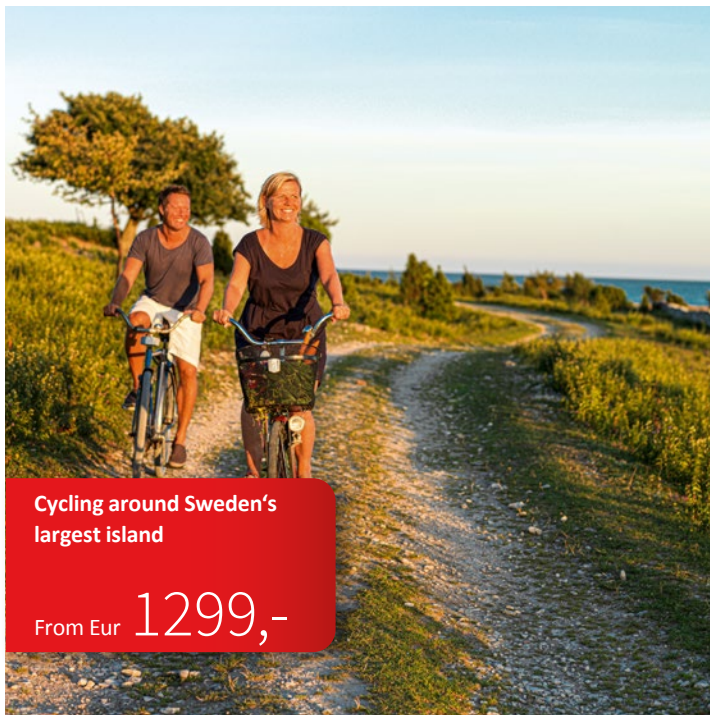


Bike tour around Gotland

Your tour

Visby is the starting point of your cycling tour around the Swedish sunny island. Past the Lummelunda Grotto and the blue lagoon, which awakens feelings of the South Seas, you cycle long stretches along the coast, always with the sea in view. The landscape is varied: barren stretches of coastline with the famous limestone pillars and the up to 27 m high Rauken, alternate with fertile meadows, beach huts from the 18th and 19th centuries and long sandy beaches.

Journey to Visby

- Nearest airports: Visby
- There are connections mainly from Stockholm, Gothenburg and Malmö.
- The shipping company Destination Gotland offers ferry connections from Nynäshamn, Oskarshamn and Västervik to Visby. At Ferryexperts, you can book the ferry in combination with a ferry from Germany or Denmark to the Swedish mainland. For example, you can travel comfortably by ferry from Travemünde, Rostock or Sassnitz to Trelleborg in southern Sweden and then drive your car to Oskarshamn in around 5 hours.

Parking in Visby

- Parking from approx. 360 SEK per day, reservation not possible, payable on site.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Visby

Discover Visby! The city is considered one of the best preserved Hanseatic cities. From the outside, it presents itself defiantly with watchtowers, gates, drawbridges and the impressive city wall. Inside the walls, stroll through the narrow, flowery streets with narrow staircases and old half-timbered houses. Make yourself comfortable in one of the numerous cafés and enjoy your first evening on Gotland.

Day 2: Visby – Kappelshamn – Fårösund, approx. 65 km + transfer

Get ready for the first stage of your cycling tour on Gotland. Cycling northwards, mostly near the coast, you will soon reach Lummelunda. The 400-million-year-old grotto, also called Robber's Cave, can be visited here during a guided tour (not included). Rauken, which are whimsical limestone pillars, can be found everywhere on Gotland. Jungfrun, the highest on the island at 27 metres, can be admired on the very first stage. The cycle tour ends today in Kappelshamn, then a transfer takes you to the island of Fårö, which is only separated from Gotland by a narrow sound.

Day 3: Fårösund – Slite, approx. 75 km

You start the day with a round trip on Fårö. Some of the impressive rhizomes can be found on the island in the Langhammars nature reserve. Before you continue your cycling tour on Gotland, it is worth visiting the Bergman Centre. The museum is dedicated to the famous director Ingmar Bergman, who lived on Fårö for many years. If you are interested in rural life on Gotland in past centuries, plan your next stop

at the cultural-historical open-air museum Bunge. Then cycle on to Slite, your destination for today. The town is characterised by tourism, but also by cement production. Slite is home to one of the largest cement plants in Northern Europe.

Day 4: Slite – Ljugarn, approx. 75 km

Today's stage of the cycle tour takes you to the east of Gotland. The region is characterised by extensive sandy beaches, rocket areas and small picturesque villages. One of the most beautiful is Grynge, a well-preserved fishing village from the 18th and 19th centuries. Here, time seems to have stood still. Let yourself be enchanted by the unique scenery of the Gotland way of life. The destination of the stage is Ljugarn, Gotland's oldest seaside resort.

Day 5: Ljugarn – Burgsvik region, approx. 65 km

Cycle through the south of Gotland today. The landscape is varied and beautiful. If you want to reach the southern tip, you will have to cycle an extra 50 kilometres. You will be rewarded in the Husrygg nature reserve with Hoburgsgubben, a rock formation in the shape of an old man's head. You continue with a beautiful view of the sea to Burgsvik. The main town in the south of Gotland has 335 inhabitants. Make yourself at home in one of the beautifully situated restaurants.

Day 6: Burgsvik – Klintehamn region, pprox. 65 km

Today your Gotland cycling tour takes you to the west coast. The small coastal road at Ekstakusten winds along endless pebble beaches to Djupvik. From here you have a wonderful view of the offshore islands. Your destination today is Klintehamn, a lively harbour town. Here you will experience the everyday life on the islands today. Barges and cutters sail incessantly in all directions. If you wish, you can take an excursion boat (not included) to the uninhabited island of Lilla Karlsö and observe the numerous bird species.

Day 7: Klintehamn – Visby, approx. 35 / 45 km

Impressive rocky coasts and beautiful sandy beaches alternate on today's stage of your cycle tour on Gotland. In Tofta it is worth taking a break and cooling off in the refreshing sea, the beach is considered one of the most beautiful and longest beaches on Gotland. The most exciting part of the cliff coast can be found in the Högklint nature reserve. From a height of almost 46 metres, you have a spectacular view of the sea and Visby, which is not far away.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
