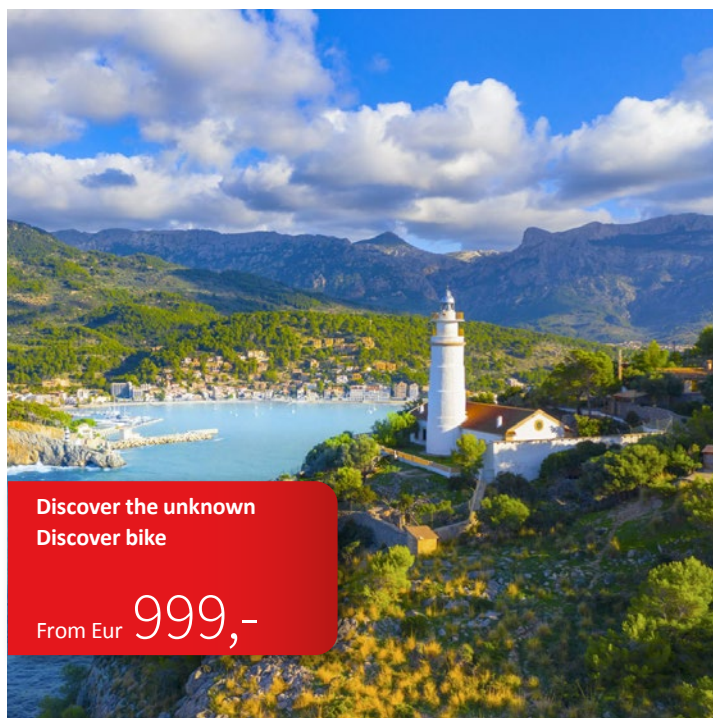


# The Great Cycle Tour of Mallorca

## Your tour

The largest of the Balearic Islands is the focus of our cycling tour in Mallorca. The island, bursting with diversity and joie de vivre, will inspire you from the very first day. The starting point of our bike tour is Playa de Palma. As a district of the island's capital Palma, the beach of the same name is known far beyond the Spanish borders. Along the coast you cycle to the settlement of Capocorb Vell and the salt fields around Colònia Sant Jordi. The dragon caves of Porto Cristo and the pearl town of Manacor are also highlights of our bike tour on Mallorca, as is a detour into the Tramuntana mountains.

## Itinerary

<b>Day 1</b>	Individual arrival to Playa de Palma
<b>Day 2</b>	Playa de Palma – Colònia Sant Jordi, approx. 55 km
<b>Day 3</b>	Colònia Sant Jordi – Porto Cristo, approx. 55 – 65 km
<b>Day 4</b>	Porto Cristo – C'an Picafort, approx. 60 km
<b>Day 5</b>	Excursion to Port de Pollença / Alcúdia, approx. 40 km
<b>Day 6</b>	C'an Picafort – Port de Sóller, approx. 50 km + bus transfer
<b>Day 7</b>	Port de Sóller – Playa de Palma, approx. 55 km
<b>Day 8</b>	Individual departure

## Stages description

### Day 1: Individual arrival to Playa de Palma

Welcome to Mallorca! You start your bike tour in Mallorca in Playa de Palma, a district of Palma. Not far from the islands capital Palma de Mallorca stretches the eponymous and most famous beach of the island. After arriving at your hotel, treat yourself to a refreshing dip in the sea or an extended walk on the beach.

### Day 2: Playa de Palma – Colònia Sant Jordi, approx. 55 km

In the morning, a personal information meeting will take place at your starting hotel. If you have booked a rental bike, you will also receive it at this time. Off you go! You cycle not far from the coast to the

prehistoric settlement of Capocorb Vell. With the typical Mallorcan windmills in view, you will reach the salt fields around Colònia Sant Jordi, your destination for today. A detour to the nearby beach Es Trenc is worthwhile. It is considered one of the most beautiful beaches on the island.

### Day 3: Colònia Sant Jordi – Porto Cristo, approx. 55 – 65 km

Not far from the coast you cycle on today's stage of your bike tour in Mallorca first to Cala Santanyi. Enjoy relaxing beach moments in the bay of the town before you continue cycling north. With the coastal town of Porto Cristo you have reached your destination for the day. Not

far from the town center are the Coves del Drac. The well-developed dragon caves take you on a journey into the world of stalactites and underground lakes. Lake Martel is one of the largest underground lakes in the world.

**Day 4: Porto Cristo – C’an Picafort, approx. 60 km**

Your bike tour on Mallorca leads you today to the northeast of the island. Via the tranquil Son Carrió you will reach Manacor. The town is famous for the production of Majorica pearls. These are artificially produced and are difficult to distinguish from real mother-of-pearl pearls. A stopover is worthwhile in Petra, especially since a typical „Mallorcan lunch snack“ awaits you here. In the birthplace of the town's most famous son, Junípero Serra, there is now a museum that traces the history of the founder of San Francisco. In Can Picafort you will be back at the sea. Visit the white beaches along the coast and experience relaxing moments overlooking the bay of Alcúdia.

**Day 5: Excursion to Port de Pollença / Alcúdia, approx. 40 km**

For today you don't have to pack your suitcase. Along the coast you will first cycle through the S'Albufera nature reserve. Enjoy the silence away from the hustle and bustle. Discover the greatest biodiversity of the Balearic Islands. The first destination of your excursion day is Alcúdia, one of the oldest towns in Mallorca. Founded on a Roman settlement, the medieval old town welcomes you with a walkable city wall. A little further north, the beaches of the Bay of Pollença offer you

a sunbath or two. In the former fishing village of Port de Pollença, an extended walk through the historic alleys is worthwhile before heading back to C'an Picafort.

**Day 6: C’an Picafort – Port de Sóller, approx. 50 km + bus transfer**

From the sea, you first cycle inland via the small town of Muro to Inca. Located at the foot of the Tramuntana mountains, the town is considered the leather capital of Mallorca. From Inca a bus (included) will take you to the monastery of Lluc. A visit to this important place of pilgrimage is possible. The transfer will take you up to 1200 meters. Back on the bike, you will descend to Fornalutx. It is considered one of the most beautiful villages in Spain. Accompanied by orange and lemon plantations you cycle to Port de Sóller, your stage destination today.

**Day 7: Port de Sóller – Playa de Palma, approx. 55 km**

Today is the last stage of your bike tour in Mallorca. Once again, you can enjoy magnificent views over the sea. Passing the picturesque villages of Deia and Valldemossa, you will reach Palma de Mallorca. Stroll through the winding streets of the old town and get to know Le Seu, the impressive cathedral visible from afar. Back on the bike you cycle along the white sandy beach to Playa de Palma.

**Day 8: Individual departure**

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
