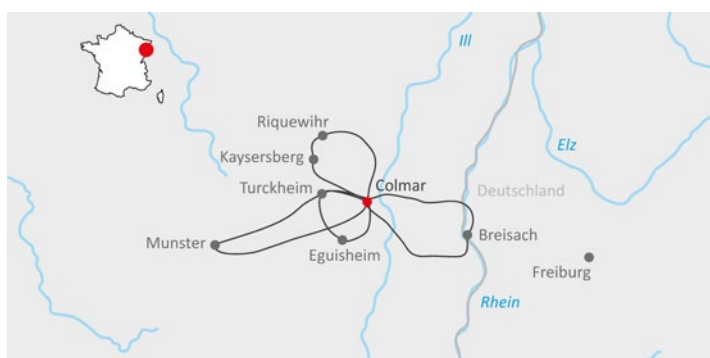

A land of tradition, a city of art and history - discover the pleasant life, excellent wines and culinary specialties of Alsace in and around Colmar. Starting from the picturesque half-timbered town on the River Ill, you cycle to the pearls of the Alsace Wine Route, the green Münster Valley and the sun-drenched Breisgau region.

Itinerary

Day 4	Excursion to Breisach, approx. 70 km

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Colmar

The capital of Alsace wines welcomes you to your cycling holiday in Alsace. Colmar welcomes you with its picturesque streets and alleyways full of charm and flair. Use the time for a first stroll through the third largest city in Alsace and enjoy your first Muscat or Riesling in a typical Winstub. Booked hire bikes are available at the hotel.

Day 2: Excursion to the wine villages, approx. 45 / 60 km

Today you can choose between two options, depending on how many kilometers you want to cover. You leave Colmar heading north on a route that reveals wine villages with incredible charm that have made the reputation of the Alsatian Grands Crus: Ribeauvillé, Hunawihr, Riquewihr, Kientzheim. The longer version invites you to discover Turckheim and Eguisheim, which are among the most beautiful villages in France.

Day 3: Excursion to Munster, approx. 45 km

Today's excursion on your cycling vacation in Alsace takes you to the Vosges. You cycle to Munster via Turckheim and Zimmerbach. The town became famous for its hearty Munster cheese. The first production of this soft cheese dates back to the 7th century. It is traditionally enjoyed with a sprinkling of caraway seeds and a glass of Alsatian Gewürztraminer. After having to tackle the odd climb on the way there, you can take it easy in the direction of Colmar.

Day 4: Excursion to Breisach, approx. 70 km

After the stages in the vineyards, today the route leads through the plain to the Rhine. The maize in the large grids is not animal feed, but goes to the chemical industry in Basel. On the Rhine lie the two sister

towns of Neuf-Brisach and Breisach, the imposing fortifications were built by Vauban, Louis XIV's master fortress builder. You cycle back to France along the typical French canals with numerous locks.

Day 5: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
