

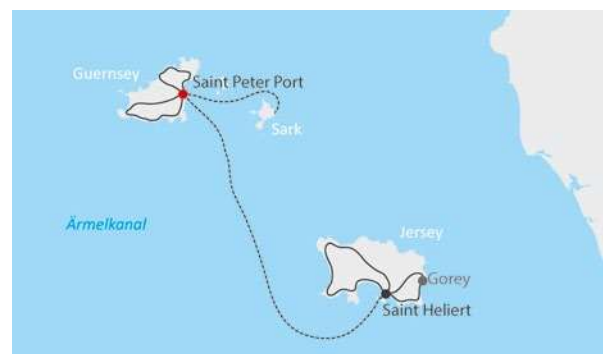
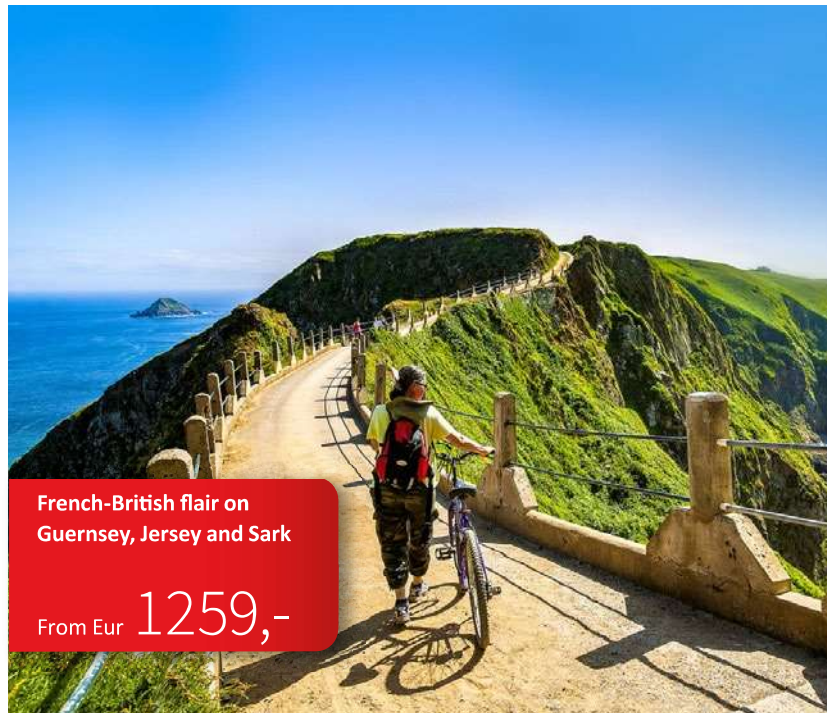

Your tour

Turquoise sea, long white sandy beaches and palm trees – and all this only about 20 km off the French Atlantic coast? The Channel Islands lie in the middle of the warm Gulf Stream and have a unique landscape: long, flat sandy beaches on Guernsey, steep cliffs on Jersey, the high rocks of Sark, which are only connected by a road. One breathtaking photo motif follows the next! And best of all, their tranquil size means that the sea is always very close.

Itinerary

Day 1	Individual arrival in St. Peter Port (Guernsey)
Day 2	Excursion to the south and west coast of the island of Guernsey, approx. 45 km
Day 3	Excursion to the island of Sark, hike + boat trips
Day 4	Excursion to the north coast of the island of Guernsey, approx. 40 km
Day 5	St. Peter Port (Guernsey) – St. Helier (Jersey), boat trip
Day 6	Excursion to the west coast island of Jersey, approx. 50 km
Day 7	Excursion to the east coast island of Jersey, approx. 35 km
Day 8	Individual departure

Journey to St. Peter Port

- Nearest airports: Guernsey, Jersey
- Travel by car to St. Malo and individual ferry trip to Guernsey

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in St. Peter Port (Guernsey)

After your arrival on Guernsey, you will first check into your hotel in St. Peter Port. You will then get to know the island's capital a little. In addition to the hilly old town center, the waterfront promenade is also worth seeing. If you arrived by ferry, you will certainly have noticed Castle Cornet. The 800-year-old castle off the coast has always guarded the harbor and is definitely worth exploring.

Day 2: Excursion to the south and west coast of the island of Guernsey, approx. 45 km

Your first cycle tour on the Channel Islands takes you into the interior of the island. You cycle along quiet paths across gently undulating meadows and fields. In Les Vauxbelets, you will visit the Little Chapel, one of the island's most popular landmarks and certainly worth a souvenir photo. You have reached the sea in Rocquaine Bay. At low tide, you can walk across to Lihou Island. Cycle back to St. Peter Port along the south coast, always with a view of the sea.

Day 3: Excursion to the island of Sark, hike + boat trips

Leave the bikes behind and take the ferry to the small island of Sark. Enjoy the journey back in time. There are no cars on the island and no street lighting. Discover the small rocky island on foot, which is no problem with an area of 5.5 km². Small wooded areas and lush meadows in the interior and the rugged rocky coastline with sand and pebble bays can also be wonderfully explored by horse-drawn carriage.

Day 4: Excursion to the north coast of the island of Guernsey, approx. 40 km

Today you will get to know the north coast of Guernsey on your cycle tour of the Channel Islands. First you cycle past the Saumarez Park gardens, which are well worth seeing. Then continue to Cobo and

Saline Bay. The long sandy beaches are among the most beautiful on the island. Even further north are the imposing coastal watchtowers such as the Rousse Tower and a well-preserved burial site from the 2nd millennium BC. Cycle back to St. Peter Port along the coast via Bordeaux.

Day 5: St. Peter Port (Guernsey) – St. Helier (Jersey), boat trip

After getting to know the island of Guernsey over the last few days, you will first take the ferry to the largest Channel Island today. Jersey's capital St. Helier is located in the south of the island on a long bay. On a tidal island near the capital is Elizabeth Castle, which is well worth a visit. At low tide you can reach the castle on foot, at high tide an amphibious vehicle will take you dry to the island.

Day 6: Excursion to the west coast island of Jersey, approx. 50 km

Cycle along the long sandy beaches to the picturesque harbor town of St. Aubin. Cycle along a former railroad line to the extreme south-western tip of the island. Here, the snow-white lighthouse sits enthroned on a tidal island and defies the storm and waves of the Atlantic. Your cycle tour on the Channel Islands takes you north along the shallow St. Ouen's Bay. After a short stop in the small harbor of Grève de Lecq Bay, you cycle back to Saint Helier.

Day 7: Excursion to the east coast island of Jersey, approx. 35 km

On the last cycle tour on the Channel Islands, you will explore the east of Jersey. The pleasantly flat route takes you to picturesque Gorey. It's a great place to stay. The relaxed fishing town with its pastel-colored houses and beautiful harbor is perfect for a longer break. Take a stroll to Mont Orgueil Castle, which towers majestically over the town. Or enjoy freshly caught fish in a restaurant with a view of the glittering sea. Refreshed, cycle back to St. Helier.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend

your stay.
