
Croatia: Bike & Boat in North Dalmatia

Your tour

Purple sage, deep green pine forests and the blue of the Adriatic Sea – these colours shape the dreamlike coastal region in northern Dalmatia. Your ship only docks at the most beautiful places: In small, hidden bathing bays with crystal-clear water and in front of idyllic fishing villages. On your bike you cycle through fragrant forests and catch fantastic views of the wide sea. A highlight are the famous Krka waterfalls, so numerous that it seems impossible to count them. You will travel on the motor sailers MS Dalmatino and MS Kažimir.

- → Helmets are compulsory for children under 18.

Journey to Zadar

- → Nearest airport: Zadar
- → A transfer can be booked from the airport to the boat and back upon request and provision of the flight number and arrival time. The price for the transfer will be determined and communicated at the beginning of 2024.

Parking in Zadar

→ Monitored parking in Trogir, cost approx. EUR 70 per week. Parking spaces must be reserved and paid for in advance.

Travel documents

- \rightarrow 1 set (per booked cabin) consists of: Voucher, travel information with description of the daily stages
- Dispatch up to four weeks before arrival. For bookings at short notice, handover on site, voucher and arrival information in advance by e-mail.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Zadar, Zadar – Island Ugljan (boat), Preko – Tkon, approx. 35 km / 200 hm, Tkon – Island Murter (boat)

Embarkation between 11.30 and 13.00 in Zadar. There is a welcome by the tour guide with welcome drink and small snack. In the meantime, the ship will cross over to Preko on the island of Ugljan. You will cycle via Kukljica and over the Ždrelac bridge to the island of Pašman. You will continue through Neviđane and Kraj to Tkon. From there you will cycle to Podvrške bay on the island of Murter.

Day 2: Island of Murter - Vodice, approx. 25 km / 170 hm

The day starts with a bike ride across the island of Murter. Via Betina you cycle to the lift bridge to Tisno. On the way to Vodice you will get to know a coastal strip with many offshore islets. Shortly before your destination, you will take time to visit Tribunj.

Day 3: Vodice – Krka National Park - Skadin, approx. 45 km / 350 hm, Skradin – Šibenik (boat).

Today starts with a bike ride to the viewpoint Okit. In the town of Skradin the ship with lunch is waiting for you. Here begins the short bike ride to the famous Krka waterfalls. The river falls over a distance of 800 meters over 17 steps into the depth. Back in Skradin you will sail to Šibenik. Enjoy dinner in the port town rich in historical buildings.

Day 4: Šibenik – Sveti Nikola Fortress, approx. 20 km / 110 hm, Šibenik – Kornati Islands National Park – Telašćica Nature Park (boat)

After breakfast, you will visit the Sveti Nikola fortress near Šibenik. Afterwards, a four to five hour boat ride through the National Park of Kornati Islands awaits you. You will dock in a protected bay in the Telašćica Nature Park. After a walk to a saltwater lake and the imposing cliffs, the crew is already waiting for you with the captains dinner.

Day 5: Cycling tour on the island of Dugi Otok, approx. 30 km / 480 hm

You will stay on the island of Dugi Otok and cycle to Sali, the main village of the island. After a coffee break you will continue to Savar via Zaglav and Luka. Lunch and dinner will be served on board. The afternoon is at your free disposal. Depending on your mood, you can sunbathe or explore the island on foot.

Day 6: Bike tour on the island of Dugi Otok, approx. 30 km / 440 hm, Dugi Otok – Island of Molat (boat)

Today's bike tour takes you to the Veli Rat lighthouse. After a break you will continue to Božava, where the ship is already waiting for you. The destination today is the island of Molat. On the way there, the captain will choose a nice bay for you to take a bathing break.

Day 7: Cycling tour on the island of Molat, approx. 20 km / 180 hm, island of Molat – Zadar (boat)

Finally, you will make a shorter bike tour from Molat via Brgulje to Zapuntel and back. On the way to Zadar there will be a bath break. Once in Zadar, a guided tour of the Venetian Old Town awaits you.

Day 8: Individual departure from Zadar

Disembarkation takes place after breakfast until 09:00. Afterwards you start your individual journey home or transfer to the airport.

Boat descriptions





MS Dalmatino, comfort category

The motor sailing boat Dalmatino was built in 1957 and fully rebuilt in 1990. You can look forward to an air-conditioned saloon and a generous 90 $\rm m^2$ sun deck with 10 sun loungers. There are also tables and benches on deck, with seating for approximately 20 people.

On the main deck there are 8 double cabins with bunk beds and on the upper deck 5 double cabins with bunk beds. There are no triple cabins on this ship. The cabin distribution is done on site.

The windows on the main and upper deck can be opened.

MS Kažimir, comfort category

The motor sailing boat MS Kazimir was first built in 1946 and completely remodelled in 1999/2000. All superstructures were removed and boat's hull was remodelled to make space for everything that Boat and Bike travellers desire. It was renovated once again between 2016 and 2019, so everything is state-of-the-art.

The MS Kazimir offers a 150 m² sun deck with deck chairs, as well as tables and chairs. The air-conditioned saloon offers space for 38 people. On the main deck there are 6 triple cabins with French bed and extra bed above and 2 double cabins with French bed and on the upper deck 4 double cabins with French bed and 3 double cabins with bunk beds. The cabin distribution is done on site.

The windows on the main and upper deck can be opened.
