Your tour

Cycling is exceptionally in the background on this bathing cruise: you are not only on the saddle, but also on foot and by kayak. Be it a city tour, a short hike, a visit to a fragrant garden or a kayak tour through the Zrmanja Canyon. Of course, swimming is not neglected either: as soon as the ship is at anchor, you can jump straight from it into the crystal-clear waves of the Adriatic! The daily excursions on the islands of the Kvarner Bay have one thing in common: they are relaxed and can be managed comfortably even by families and the inexperienced. And if you don't feel like going ashore, you can simply stay on board and let the sun shine on your belly button.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Rijeka, Rijeka – Cres Island (by boat), swimming, walks along the coast and tours of the towns

The crew of your ship will be waiting for you in the port of Rijeka between 11.00 and 12.30! Over a welcome drink you will get to know the crew and fellow passengers while your romantic motor sailer sets sail for the first time. On the way, a stop will be made in one of the bays so that you can take that long-awaited, first plunge into the sea! Once on the island of Cres, you can join in a walk by the sea. After dinner, there will be plenty of time for a stroll around town.

Day 2: Cres island - Lošinj island (by boat), swimming, cappuccino and scent garden

During the crossing to the island of Lošinj, you will observe the Kvarner Bay passing by. With a bit of luck, you might spot a group of Adriatic dolphins today. After lunch on board, you will moor in the port of Mali Lošinj. Afterwards, you can join the bike tour to the picturesque town of Veli Lošinj. On the way back, you will visit a nearby "Mediterranean Scent Garden". During a guided tour you will learn more about the approximately 250 different fragrant plants that grow and thrive in the garden.

Day 3: Lošinj island – Zadar (by boat), bike tour approx. 20 km, swimming and town tour

During an easy hike on foot or a relaxed bike ride on the saddle you will explore the unspoilt island of Molat . You will be back on board in time for lunch. During the crossing to Zadar you will take an extensive bathing break in a bay. The old town of Zadar, your destination today, is surrounded by mighty walls. During an entertaining guided tour of the city, you will learn all kinds of interesting facts about the time-honoured buildings and their history.

Day 4: Zadar – Pag island (by boat), kayak tour and swimming under water falls

Today you leave the sea and paddle on the river Zrmanja to the canyon of the same name. A bus transfer takes you to the entry point, where you also pick up your kayak. The karst river glistens in its typical emerald green colour. After a few bends and rapids, enchanting waterfalls await you at one of the rivers most beautiful spots. Splashing around in the water here is a unique experience. After a picnic, you continue paddling through the Zrmanja canyon. After the tour, the bus will take you back to your ship in Mandre. Note: If the water level is very high, the excursion is carried out with large inflatable boats (rafting).

Day 5: Pag island – Rab island (by boat), bike tour approx. 20 km, swimming, town tour and walk along coast

Today you will take a closer look at the island of Pag with its partly barren, partly lush green meadows: more precisely, you will sail to Lun on the north-western tip of the island. A remarkable 80,000 olive trees grow here! Some of them have already reached an age of about 1200 years! You will learn all this and more during a guided tour through the grove. After an extensive bathing break, the ship crosses over to Rab. The old town of Rab stretches over an elongated headland. The characteristic bell towers of the four churches can be seen from afar. If you wish, you can take part in a guided tour of the most important buildings in the town.

Day 6: Rab island – Krk island (by boat), bike tour approx. 15 km, walk and swimming

On Rab, you have several options to explore the island: Either on an easy bike tour or a mountain hike. On foot, you can climb Kamenjak, which rises 408 m above the sea. An impressive panorama opens up from its summit: your view sweeps over the Kvarner Bay with its islands

and nature parks, the small and large towns and the seemingly endless expanse of the Mediterranean. Back on board, you immediately head for one of the numerous lonely bays. The next destination is the island of Krk, one of the largest islands in the Adriatic. The evening ends with a cosy Captains Dinner.

Day 7: Krk island – Rijeka (by boat), town tour, swimming and hike Start the day with a leisurely stroll through the city. As today is your last day on board the ship, a particularly long bathing break is on the programme. You will then set course for Rijeka. After the ship is safely moored, there is enough time for a hike to the pilgrimage site Trsat, which is located above the city. The climb of 485 steps is worth it, because from the fortress you have a wonderful view over the Kvarner Bay.

Day 8: Individual departure from Rijeka

Disembarkation takes place after breakfast until 09:00. Afterwards you start your individual journey home or transfer to the airport.

After captain Jure Tomaš installed a new engine in his MS Planka, the ship was completely reconstructed in 2005. Meanwhile Jure's elder son Marin is at the helm of this classic wooden ship. You will travel personally taken care of by the crew, who will cook delicious regional dishes for you every day. On the huge sun deck you can relax and if it gets too hot, just jump directly from the ship into the crystal clear Mediterranean Sea to refresh yourself.

If it gets too hot, just jump directly from the ship into the crystal clear Mediterranean Sea to refresh yourself.

Since his son took over the helm of the MS Planka in 2015, Captain Jure Tomaš has been taking care of his new ship, the MS Aria. Aria, by the way, stands for air in the Dalmatian dialect. The majestic motor sailer set sail for the first time in spring 2016. Look forward to sailing on a new, comfortable ship, be pampered by the crew and relax in a deck chair on the large sun deck from the wonderful cycling tours. The jump into the crystal clear water can be done comfortably from the bathing platform.

Facts about the ship:

- → 18 outside cabins, approx. 9 13 m²
- → Equipment cabins: Shower / WC, individually controlled air conditioning
- → Lower deck:
 - 2 triple cabins with two single beds and a third bed above,
 - 4 double cabins with french bed,
 - 2 double cabins with single beds that can be pushed together to form a double bed
- → Main deck:
 - 6 double cabins with French bed
- → Upper deck:
 - 4 double cabins with single beds that can be pushed together to form a double bed.
- → The cabin allocation is done on the spot.
- $\ensuremath{\rightarrow}$ The portholes in the cabins on the main deck can be opened
- → On the lower deck there is a ventilation system that provides fresh air even when the portholes are closed
- → Built in 2016
