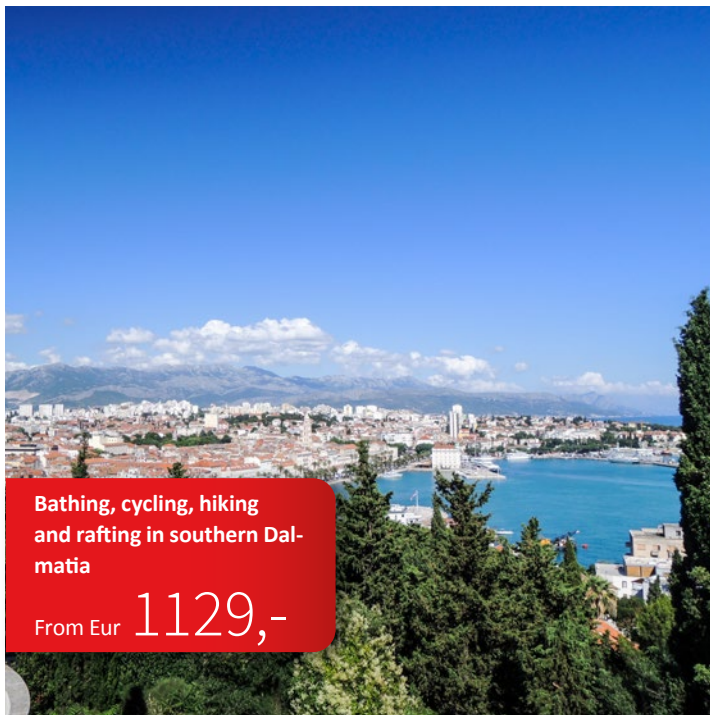

Your tour

During the family cruise, not only short bike tours are on the programme, but also easy hikes, boat trips, numerous swimming breaks and an exciting rafting tour through the Cetina Canyon. Families with older children will have a lot of fun. Because the programme is designed according to the motto: Everything can, nothing must! So you can decide every day what you want to do. The family cruise takes you to the most beautiful beaches in the south of Croatia and leads you to the hidden corners in the centuries-old towns. During the daily swimming breaks, you jump straight from your motor sailer into the crystal-clear waters of the Mediterranean.

Itinerary

Day 1	Individual arrival in Trogir, Trogir – Split (boat), swimming break, city tour and walk
Day 2	Split – Makarska Riviera (boat), rafting tour and swimming break
Day 3	Makarska Riviera – Kućište (boat), bike tour approx. 10 km, short hike and wine tasting
Day 4	Kućište – Mljet island – Korčula island (boat), guided walk, boat trip and swimming break
Day 5	Korčula island – Hvar island (boat), Bike tour approx. 15 km, cappuccino, swimming break, city walk and short hike
Day 6	Hvar island – Brač island (boat), approx. 25 km, bike tour and swimming break
Day 7	Brač island – Trogir (boat), Bike tour approx. 15 km, swimming break and city tour
Day 8	Individual departure from Trogir

- Changes: Changes are possible on boat trips due to weather, water level or technical conditions and remain reserved.
- Arrival dates MS Mirabela (Comfort-category): 01.06. / 15.06. / 29.06. / 17.08. / 14.09. / 28.09.
- Arrival dates MY Mystic (Deluxe-category): 29.06. / 13.07. / 27.07. / 10.08. / 24.08.
- For safety reasons we generally recommend wearing a helmet. When booking a rental bike, a rental helmet is included, please state your head circumference when booking. For an optimal fit, we recommend bringing your own helmet.
- Helmets are compulsory for children under 18.

Journey to Trogir

- Nearest airport: Split
- A transfer can be booked from the airport to the boat and back upon request and provision of the flight number and arrival time. The price for the transfer will be determined and communicated at the beginning of 2024.

Parking in Trogir

- Monitored parking in Trogir, cost approx. EUR 70 per week. Parking spaces must be reserved and paid for in advance.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Trogir, Trogir – Split (boat), swimming break, city tour and walk

You will be expected at Trogir harbour between 12 and 2 pm. Before departure you will receive your rental bike and go for a test ride. As the boat weighs anchor, you will get to know the crew and your fellow travellers in the relaxed atmosphere on board. On the crossing to Split, we take our first break for a swim. Split is the second largest city in Croatia and also the capital of Dalmatia. After an entertaining city tour through the alleys of the old town, you can join a walk through the forest park Marjan.

Day 2: Split – Makarska Riviera (boat), rafting tour and swimming break

This day the highlight of your cruise: the rafting tour is coming up! Abstract rock formations towering up to 180 m above the water mark the Cetina Canyon. An experienced skipper will instruct you in the technique and equipment and then you are ready to go: You will sail down the river over rapids and past waterfalls. During two breaks you can refresh yourself in the river or jump daringly from a 5 m high rock into the water. If you do not want to join the rafting tour, you will have plenty of time to visit the town of Omiš. Back on board, your ship will take you to Makarska Riviera. Makarska Riviera is best known for its fine, light pebble beaches, which are repeatedly interrupted by rugged rocky sections.

Day 3: Makarska Riviera – Kučište (boat), bike tour approx. 10 km, short hike and wine tasting

Your ship will take you to the Pelješac peninsula today. The southern Dalmatian town is not only a popular holiday destination, but also a famous wine-growing area. Famous Croatian wines such as Postup and Dingač thrive particularly well on the peninsula! A beautiful cycle route takes you from Kučište to Orebić, the largest town on the island. After a short tour of the town, you will hike to the Franciscan monastery from the 16th century. Back in Orebić, a tasty wine tasting awaits you. Can you taste the sun over Croatia? Afterwards, you cycle back to your motor sailer.

Day 4: Kučište – Mljet island – Korčula island (boat), guided walk, boat trip and swimming break

During breakfast you will sail to the island of Mljet, which is widely protected as a national park. A guided walk will show you the beauties of the untouched nature. In the middle of the park are two salt lakes, which are only connected to the sea by a narrow channel. In the larger of the two lakes, there is a small monastery island. You will cross over to the island by boat. Hopefully you have your swimsuit with you, because the water of the salt lake is usually 2°C warmer than that of the Mediterranean. Back on board your ship, the next destination is Korčula on the island of the same name.

Day 5: Korčula island – Hvar island (boat), Bike tour approx. 15 km, cappuccino, swimming break, city walk and short hike

The island of Korčula is covered in large parts with dense pine forests. A short bike ride brings you to Račišće. However, you cycle less through the forests and more directly along the sea. In Račišće, your ship is already waiting for you. But before you go on board, we invite you to a cappuccino. The crossing to the island of Hvar is of course interrupted for an extensive bathing break. Once in Hvar, you can join a guided walk through the town of the same name and then hike to the Španjola fortress. The 20-minute climb is worth it, as you will have a wonderful view over the town and the offshore islands. Back on board, the ship sets course for one of the surrounding bays. In this idyllic place, the Captain's Dinner is on the programme today.

Day 6: Hvar island – Brač island (by boat), approx. 25 km, bike tour and swimming break

In the morning you will sail around the north-western tip of Hvar to the oldest settlement on the island. Stari Grad has long since relinquished its supremacy to Hvar; only the palace still bears witness to its past glory. Explore the island and the romantic fishing village of Jesla on your bike before your ship sets course for the island of Brač. The most

famous beach in Croatia awaits you: Zlatni Rat, the Golden Horn. The bright beach juts out several hundred metres into the Mediterranean Sea. Bathing, splashing and swimming are especially fun at this place

Day 7: Brač island – Trogir (boat), Bike tour approx. 15 km, swimming break and city tour

A short bike tour brings you closer to the island of Brač. Of course, there will be a stop at the Golden Horn so that you can refresh yourself in the Mediterranean Sea. You will then sail around the south-west coast to a secluded bay where lunch will be served. Take advantage of the time for an extensive bathing break, because now the last crossing of your cruise in Croatia is already on the agenda: You set course back to Trogir. The museum town with its mighty walls and fortified towers is protected as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. A guided tour of the city allows you to look into the old courtyards and explains all kinds of interesting facts about the city. You will spend the night in the harbour.

Day 8: Individual departure from Trogir

Disembarkation is after breakfast until 09.00. Then you set off on your individual journey home or get your transfer to the airport.

Boat descriptions



MS Mirabela – Comfort category

The Vuković family is all about shipping and hospitality. Silvio Vuković was the first captain of the motor sailer Mirabela from the family, and his brother Josip was there from the beginning. In 2013, Silvio's son Ante finally took over the command, which he finally passed on to his younger brother Luka in 2017. So you can be sure that you are in the best hands aboard this ship. Enjoy the varied program and relax on board with a cool drink in one of the deck chairs.

- 11 outside cabins, 4 – 5 m²
- Equipment: shower / WC, individually adjustable air conditioner
- Main deck:
 - 2 double cabins with bunk bed
 - 4 triple cabins with French bed and 3rd bed above it
- Upper deck:
 - 5 double cabins with bunk bed
- Cabins are allocated on site.
- Year of construction 1950
- Renovated in 2005
- 2 passenger decks
- Maximum occupancy: 26 passengers
- Length: 25,50 m
- Equipment: sun deck approx. 100 m² with deck chairs, salon with air conditioning
- Board languages: German, English

Boat descriptions



MY Mystic – Deluxe Category

Since 2015, the motor yacht Mystic has been delighting its guests off the coast of Dalmatia. Comfortable cabins on two passenger decks, a spacious salon and an extensive sun deck are just as much part of the ship's equipment as a bathing platform at the stern, which encourages spontaneous jumps into the sea.

Facts about the ship:

- 17 outside cabins, approx. 14 m²
- Equipment: shower / WC, individually adjustable air conditioner
- Main deck:
 - 7 double cabins with single beds
 - 2 double cabins with french bed
- Lower deck:
 - 4 double cabins with single beds
 - 2 double cabins with french bed
 - 2 triple cabins with french bed and adjacent single bed
- The cabins on the lower deck have portholes and cannot be opened.
- The windows of the cabins on the main deck can be opened
- Year of construction 2015
- 2 passenger decks
- Maximum occupancy: 40 passengers
- Length: 42 m
- Width: 8 m
- Equipment: sun deck about 220 m² with 40 sun loungers, air-conditioned salon for 40 people on the upper deck, comfortable seating for about 20 people in the lounge area on the covered upper deck behind the salon, which can be closed with tarpaulins depending on the weather, bathing platform with shower at the stern.
