Your tour

You will explore Upper Italy on predominantly flat trails. You start in Dobbiaco in the impressive Alta Pusteria. From the saddle of your bike you can see the striking peaks of the „Three Peaks“ as you pass by. Look forward to the sophisticated Cortina d'Ampezzo and the magnificent palaces of Treviso. Finally, La Serenissima, Venice, awaits you with 175 canals, graceful bridges and the Piazza San Marco, St Mark's Square.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Niederdorf / Toblach

Your e-bike-tour around the Dolomites begins in the middle of the Hochpustertal (the high Puster Valley), at its highest point in Toblach or Niederdorf. The watershed between the Adriatic and the Black Sea is located here. A visit to the Höhlenstein Valley with a view of the majestic Drei Zinnen (Tre Cime di Lavaredo) is recommended. The winter sport town of Toblach also has much to offer, even in Summer.

Day 2: Toblach – Cortina d'Ampezzo, approx. 30 – 35 km

Along the former Dolomite railway you cycle south through the Höhlenstein Valley and past Dobbiaco Lake. Again and again, magnificent views of the Three Peaks open up to you. In Gemärk you have not only reached the pass, but also the border to Veneto. From now on, the route takes you at a brisk pace to Cortina, a Ladin municipality, Olympic town in 1956 and setting for a James Bond film.

Day 3: Cortina d'Ampezzo – Belluno, approx. 75 km

This cycling stage belongs to Cadore, a valley landscape framed by the Dolomites, which belonged to the Republic of Venice in the Middle Ages, then to the Habsburg Empire for a long time. The route of the former Dolomite railway makes cycling pleasantly easy.

Day 4: Belluno – Feltre, approx. 40 km

In the shade of the deciduous forest avenues, you cycle through the hilly landscape of Belluno past Cesiomaggiore, which lies picturesquely at the foot of the Dolomites. Here you can stop off and visit the Museo di Bicicletta, which documents the development of the bicycle. Continue through the fertile countryside to Feltre, a Renaissance town with a small university and typical Mediterranean houses.

Day 5: Feltre – Bassano del Grappa, approx. 55 km

Shortly after Feltre you will pass the picturesquely situated Lago di Corlo. You can take a dip in the water, which is up to 25° C warm, before cycling out of the enchanting Alpine landscape. After a brisk descent, you reach the Brenta Valley, where the river of the same

name leads you to Bassano del Grappa. The town is famous for its good schnapps. However, the neighbouring mountain Monte Grappa gave it its name.

Day 6: Bassano del Grappa – Treviso, approx. 55 km

With the breathtaking backdrop of the Alps, you cycle through the Po Valley. On your way, you can admire many magnificent villas by the Italian master builder Palladio. The historic town of Asolo was the residence of the last Lusignan Queen of Cyprus. Then you reach Treviso, also called the water city because of its countless canals. Numerous production sites of Italian fashion are located here.

Day 7: Treviso – Venice-Mestre, approx. 45 km

The sea is no longer far away. You cycle along the quietly flowing Sile River to Casale, a small town with a few villas worth seeing. Passing a romantic boat cemetery in an extensive nature area, you will soon reach the lagoon of Venice and the district of Mestre, the destination of your journey. From here you can easily and quickly reach the Venetian old town in the evening.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
