Experience a diverse cultural programme, enjoy the beauty of the varied landscape to the left and right of the river. Try out the skills of the local winegrowers, because you can hardly buy good Württemberg wine outside the state people prefer here to drink it by themselves.

- $\boldsymbol{\rightarrow}$  Closest airports: Frankfurt am Main, Stuttgart, Karlsruhe
- → Train station: Tübingen main station; Long-distance travellers have to change trains in Stuttgart or Horb

#### Parking in Tübingen

- → Parking garage Altstadt Mitte, parking garage Altstadt König & parking garage Metropol, costs approx. 42 EUR per week.
- → Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents)

#### Return trip to Tübingen

- → Optional with a minibus always on Saturdays between 09.00 10.00 am, must be specified when booking.
- → On your own by train, connection every two hours, duration approx. two hours, 1 2 changes

#### Bike handover

→ Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.

Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

#### Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

#### **Travel documents**

- → 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- → Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

#### Stages description

#### Day 1: Individual arrival in Tübingen

Tübingen is geographically speaking bang in the middle of Baden-Württemberg. It's a popular university town and has almost 30,000 students. Visit the pretty historic quarter and Hohentübingen Castle, which gives you a great view of the town. If you have enough time, try a trip by punt or visit the nearby Bebenhausen monastery.

#### Day 2: Tübingen - Esslingen, approx. 55 km

You leave this lively town and soon pedal past various bathing lakes - great for a refreshening swim. Downstream along the Neckar you cycle through the valley to Plochingen which features a tower by Hundertwasser. Esslingen, which escaped damage from the war, is a tempting town to visit with its special historic flair.

#### Day 3: Esslingen - Ludwigsburg, approx. 35 km

Firstly, you reach Stuttgart, the capital of the federal state of Baden-Württemberg and its largest city. Take a break there and visit the Mercedes-Benz Museum or the Old Palace. Cycle on to Ludwigsburg with its famous Baroque palace.

#### Day 4: Ludwigsburg – Heilbronn / Neckarsulm, approx. 55 / 60 km

You cycle back to the Neckar and follow the river meanders through picturesque vineyards to Lauffen, where you should treat yourself to a sip of the delicious Katzenbeißer. From Heilbronn, a centre of viticulture and wine trade, you cycle on along the romantic Castle Road to Heilbronn or Neckarsulm.

#### Day 5: Heilbronn - Mosbach / Eberbach, approx. 40 - 60 km

## Day 6: Eberbach – Heidelberg, ca. 60 / 35 km

The Neckar now meanders through the Odenwald and forms the border between Hesse and Baden-Württemberg. The famous university town of Heidelberg awaits with its famous castle ruins, which you should definitely visit. From there you have a fantastic view over the city.

#### Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
