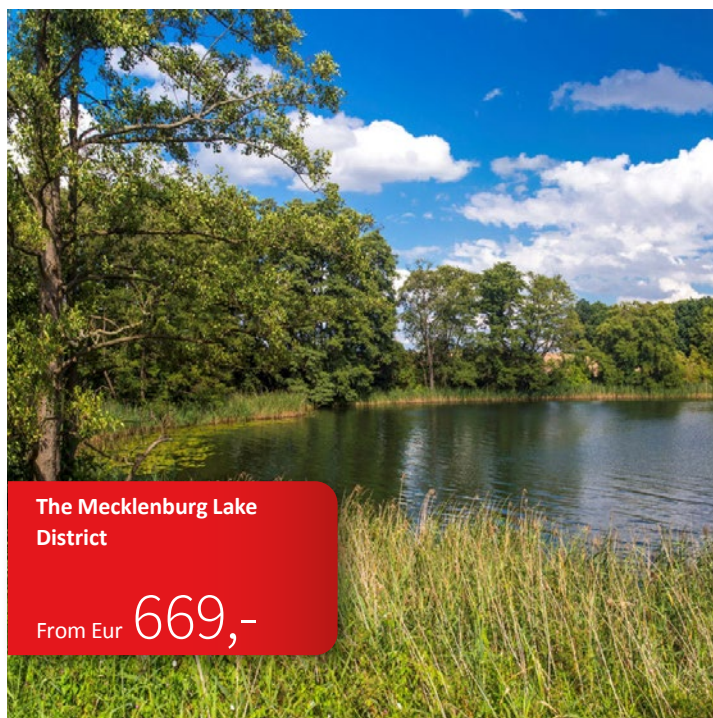

Your tour

Your cycling tour along the Müritz is defined by the lush green of the plants and the crystal-clear blue of the water. The Müritz and Lake Plauer See, the small waterways and the moors, which seem to be enchanted, are populated by rare animal and plant species. You cycle along the long stretches of shoreline, along the German Alley Road and through the Müritz National Park. In the picturesque towns and villages you will find half-timbered houses, typical red brick buildings and a wide variety of locks.

Day 6	Plau am See – Waren (Müritz) / Klink, approx. 60 km

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Waren (Müritz) / Klink

In Waren, which has been recognized as a climatic health resort since the beginning of the 19th century, you are already in the middle of the Mecklenburg Lake District. The Müritz is the largest lake in Germany. In the Müritzeum, the „House of 1000 Lakes“, you can learn more about life on, in and around the water - the ideal introduction to your cycle tour through the lake district and Mecklenburg Switzerland.

Day 2: Waren (Müritz) – Neustrelitz region, approx. 55 km

Your first stage is dominated by the Müritz National Park. The extensive area appears almost deserted. Small ponds and larger lakes lie like drops to the right and left of the path in the middle of mysterious moors. Impressive ospreys and sea eagles accompany you on your cycle tour to Neustrelitz.

Day 3: Neustrelitz – Wesenberg Lake Cross, approx. 55 km

Shortly after Neustrelitz, you reach the eastern part of the Müritz National Park. In Fürstenberg, the Brandenburg gateway to the Mecklenburg Lake District, you cross the waterway to Berlin, where there is usually a lot of boat traffic. Your cycle tour finally takes you to the Wesenberger Seenkreuz, where smaller and larger lakes lie close together.

Day 4: Wesenberg Lake Cross – Röbel region, approx. 45 km

If you want to be pampered like a prince on the third stage, then be sure to plan a break in Mirow! On the castle island, you will find the baroque castle, the Gothic church with the princely crypt and the

former ice cellars. A restaurant has been opened here where you can dine like a knight. After an extensive visit, continue your cycle tour to Röbel. Climb the church tower. From the top you can enjoy a wonderful view over the Müritz.

Day 5: Röbel – Plau am See, approx. 40 km

The Mecklenburg Lake Cycle Path takes you towards Plau on the lake of the same name. At the southern tip of the lake, you can observe the 19 brown bears in the Müritz Bear Forest or take a hike through the Valley of the Kingfishers. Once you arrive in Plau, you should definitely pay a visit to the castle tower. The 3 m thick walls have defied all adversity for over 500 years and are just as impressive as the 11 m deep dungeon.

Day 6: Plau am See – Waren (Müritz) / Klink, approx. 60 km

Experience pure nature on this varied cycle tour around the shores of Lake Plau. You cycle through beech forests and dry grassland, mostly along the water and on natural paths. Alt-Schwerin is idyllically situated in the middle of this pristine natural landscape. The island town of Malchow was once only connected to the mainland by a simple wooden bridge, and with a fresh breeze around your nose, you roll relaxed through fields and meadows, past idyllic villages and extensive stretches of forest to Waren.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
