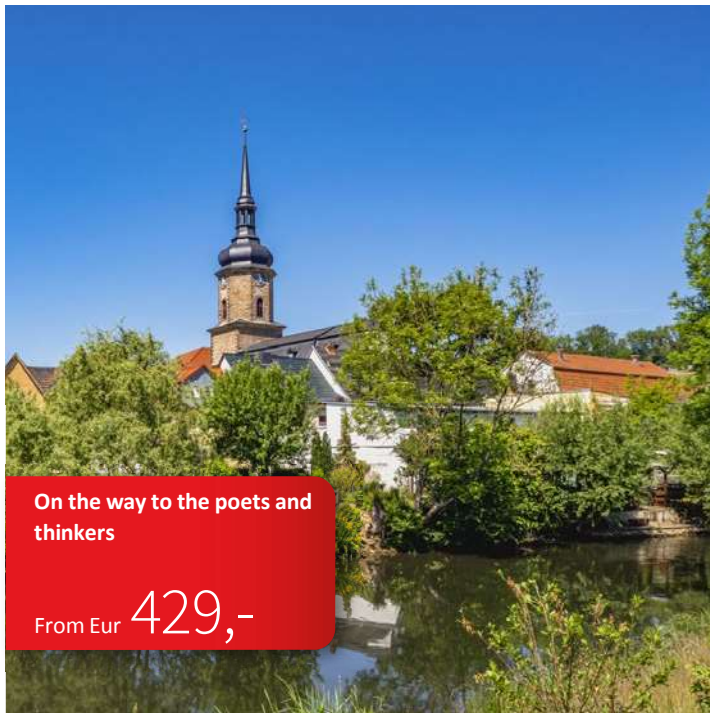

Your tour

If you want to follow in the footsteps of great poets, thinkers and artists, Stern cycle tours around Weimar are just the thing. Day trips take you to the highlights of Weimar's environs. Along the rivers Ilm, Saale and Gera you will encounter historic palaces, majestic castles and churches steeped in history. Cycle along well-maintained cycle paths, some of which take you through slightly hilly terrain. The Stern cycle tours around Weimar are particularly suitable for those interested in culture and nature as well as for pleasure cyclists who want to get to know the green heart of Thuringia.

Parking in Weimar

- Depending on hotel availability, there are free parking spaces and an underground garage (approx. €15 per day, can be reserved). No reservation possible through Radweg-Reisen. Free parking spaces are available in the surrounding area, subject to availability.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Weimar

Weimar is the city of poets and thinkers. Names such as Goethe, Schiller and Friedrich Liszt, as well as great female personalities such as Duchess Anna Amalia, still characterize the city of culture today. The city palace, a magnificent princely residence, and the state Bauhaus from 1919 are further landmarks of the city. You can experience opera, drama and dance up close at the Deutsches Nationaltheater.

Day 2: Excursion to Erfurt, approx. 60 km

On your last stage you will drive along the Thuringian city chain to Erfurt. Stroll through Erfurt's alleys to the fish market and the famous Krämerbrücke. Discover the Erfurt Cathedral, which has the Gloriosa, the largest free-swinging bell in the world, before cycling back to Weimar. Alternatively, the trip back is possible by train incl. bike (not included).

Day 3: Excursion to the Ilm valley, approx. 65 km

Cycle through the picturesque Ilm valley today, through Bad Berka with its Kneipp pool for cyclists' calves, past the Munich manor, via Kranichfeld with its two castles to Hohenfelden. This area is ideal for picnics and swimming. Take a boat trip through this popular recreational area and visit one of the many cafés and restaurants that invite you to take a break. The Thuringian open-air museum is also worth a visit.

Day 4: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
