## Your tour

Until the beginning of the 19th century, large parts of northern Germany were covered by extensive areas of heath. In the meantime, these only exist in the Lüneburg Heath. Heath plants cover the ground here in many places. They alternate with pine forests, meadows and fields. In between, you can always see the typical heath sheep grazing. Pretty little towns and villages blend harmoniously into the overall picture. This unique natural area has inspired numerous poets and painters. On various cycling tours around the Heidestadt Schneverdingen you can experience the dreamlike landscape at first hand: Romantic cycling holidays in the Lüneburg Heath!

## Stages description

### Day 1: Individual arrival to Schneverdingen

In case you have pre-booked a rental bike, it will be handed over today. Also you will receive some important informations for your cycle holiday. Schneverdingen is an ideal place to start exploring Lüneburg Heath. The town itself also has a lot to discover. At the end of August, when Lüneburg Heath turns into a sea of purple heather, is when the Heather Bloom Festival takes place.

### Day 2: Excursion through the Höpen recreation area, approx. 30 km

The Aueweg leads you through fields and meadows via the Fintau river to Wintermoor. This is where you'll find the Höpen nature reserve. You will see the entire range of vegetation typical for Lüneburg Heath. And grazing in the nooks and crannies of this expansive heathland and behind the juniper bushes are the Lüneburg Heidschnucke sheep. There are 130 different species in the show garden alone!

### Day 3: Excursion to Lünzen watermill and Fintel, approx. 35 km

Passing Walter-Peters-Park you cycle into a village called Zahrensen. From here you continue through Veerse valley to Lünzen. Lünzen has a watermill that dates back to the 13th century. And it was in operation until the end of the 1970s. One of the original two water wheels has been renovated and can be admired! The return trip to Schneverdingen takes you through the villages of Haswede and Osterwede.

### Day 4: Schneverdingen – Soltau (train), Soltau – Schneverdingen, approx. 45 km

In the morning the train takes you on a 15-minute trip to the town of Soltau. Worthy of a visit here are the various churches, the town hall and also a toy museum, which shows exhibits from over four centuries. On the way back to Schneverdingen, you encounter the historic site of Wieheholz. Through the southern Osterheide and the woods around Böhnheide, your route takes you back to your starting point.

### Day 5: Excursion to Wilseder Berg, approx. 30 km

Today's destination is Wilsede, a small village on the heath with about 50 inhabitants. The village, in the middle of the heath, can only be reached by foot, bike or horse and cart. Visit the heath museum, which tells you more about life as a farmer in 1850. Finally cycle through woods and heathland to Niederhaverbeck and then return via Haverbeeke Valley.

### Day 6: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
