Your overnight stops, especially Český Krumlov, will delight you with beautiful historical buildings from different eras. After a week through the hilly landscape of the Czech Republic and Upper Austria, the three-river city of Passau marks the end of your cycling tour.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Prague

Welcome to your bike tour from Prague! An early arrival in the Golden City is recommended, so you can also enjoy one of the most beautiful cities in Europe to the fullest. Stroll past the Astronomical Clock, across Charles Bridge to Prague Castle! From here you have a breathtaking view of the city. In the evening, try the famous Czech beer in one of the many small pubs.

Day 2: Prague – Sedlčany, approx. 65 km

Along the Vltava River, you leave the urban jungle and soon encounter small, idyllic Bohemian villages. You will enjoy the varied hilly landscape and marvel at the many small houses with wood-clad gables along

the way. You will pass numerous pubs where you should take a break and taste the Czech cuisine. How about roast pork, dumplings and sauerkraut?

Day 3: Sedlčany – Písek, approx. 70 km

Also today you will cycle mostly along the Vltava River. You will cross the Bohemian Forest and again encounter numerous picturesque villages. Soon you will reach the Vltava reservoir at Milešov and cycle on to Orlík. Visit the Gothic castle perched on a rocky spur above the Vltava River. Just a few kilometers further, the next castle awaits you. On a small promontory at the confluence of the Vltava and Otava rivers lies Zvíkov Castle. In the Middle Ages, it was one of the most important castles in Bohemia. Today's destination is the picturesque town of Písek on the tributary of the Vltava - the gold-rich Otava.

Day 4: Písek – Budweis, approx. 70 km

On today's stage you will mainly follow the Vltava River. You will be fascinated by the fascinating primeval and cultural landscapes. On the way you will meet one of the oldest South Bohemian towns - Týn nad Vitavou. A small forest path will lead you to the next highlight - Hluboká Castle with an impressive park. High above the Vltava River towers the magnificent building, which once originated from a castle. Windsor Castle was the model for this, which can be clearly seen. Your stage destination is Budweis, famous for its beer. After the day's exertions, don't miss out on a taste. Cheers!

Day 5: Budweis – Český Krumlov, approx. 30 km

Take advantage of the shortness of today's stage to take a closer look at České Budějovice. Get back on your bike and follow the Vltava Cycle Path. Along the way, you will come across secluded little farming villages before another highlight of your journey awaits you at today's stage destination. Český Krumlov, also known by its German name Krumau, is one of the most beautiful towns in the Czech Republic. The town is considered the pearl of Šumava and there is something to discover on almost every corner. Take a stroll through the old town, lined with historic buildings in Renaissance and Baroque style. You also have to see the extensive castle complex high above the Vltava.

Day 6: Český Krumlov – Aigen, approx. 70 km

The stage through the Green Roof of Europe - the Bohemian Forest will put a bead or two of sweat on your forehead. You will tackle some tough climbs, but your efforts will be rewarded by the magnificent panoramic views. You pass through deep coniferous forests and enjoy the silence and pure air until you come across an imposing castle complex in Rosenburg. The Vltava soon dams up to form the Lipno reservoir. Take the opportunity to refresh yourself after all your efforts. You say goodbye to the Czech Republic and cross the border into Austria. You have reached your overnight stay in Aigen in the romantic Mühlviertel.

Day 7: Aigen – Passau, approx. 75 km or approx. 55 km + boat trip

The last stage of your cycle tour on the Vltava Cycle Path takes you through the beautiful Mühlviertel region to the Danube. The route takes you through beautiful wooded areas where you can really enjoy the peace and quiet once again. You pass gently rolling chains of hills and, in good weather, are rewarded with magnificent panoramic views of the Alps. You soon reach the Danube, which meanders gently through the valley. Passing the Schlögener Schlinge, you approach Passau. If you prefer to enjoy the scenery from the comfort of a boat, you can also shorten the last few kilometers to Passau by boat from Engelhartszell. Stroll through the picturesque baroque town of Passau in the evening.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
