Your tour

This tour connects the Austrian "Mozart city" Salzburg with the Czech capital Prague. You cycle to the Wolfgangsee, through the beautiful Salz-kammergut, to the imperial town of Bad Ischl, along the Traun to Linz and through the romantic Mühlviertel to southern Bohemia. Following the course of the Vltava, you will get to know the beautiful old town of Český Krumlov, walk in the footsteps of a long brewing tradition in ?eské Bud?jovice and finally arrive in Prague, the "Golden City" with its many sights.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Salzburg

Plan an early arrival in the world-famous Mozart city of Salzburg. Numerous historical and cultural sights such as the Mirabell and Hellbrunn castles and Getreidegasse with Mozarts birthplace await you. We recommend a visit to the Hohensalzburg Fortress, which towers high above the city. Enjoy the wonderful view of the baroque old town from there.

Day 2: Salzburg – St. Gilgen am Wolfgangsee, approx. 45 km

It is with a heavy heart that you leave Salzburg. But be aware, the next days of your bike tour from Salzburg to Prague will be no less exciting! The first stage takes you through Salzburg's Flachgau region. Along the former historic Ischlerbahn route you will cycle through places worth seeing such as Eugendorf and Thalgau to Mondsee. Take advantage of the time for an extensive lunch break on the shore before continuing to Lake Wolfgang. With St. Gilgen you have reached your destination for today. Although Mozart was never here, he is still omnipresent. After all, not only were his grandfather and mother born here, but his sister also found her new home here.

Day 3: St. Gilgen – Traunsee – Linz, approx. 60 km + Train ride

First you cycle along the shore of the Wolfgangsee. The view of the lake embedded in mountain landscapes will inspire you. You can refresh yourself with a jump into the cool water before continuing your journey. The Ischler Ache leads you to the imperial town of Bad Ischl. Use the time to visit the Kaiservilla, where once Empress Elisabeth and Emperor Franz Joseph spent the summer months. Continue along the course of the Traun River until you soon reach Ebensee on Lake Traunsee. In Gmunden it is goodbye Salzkammergut. By train you will travel to the Upper Austrian capital Linz on the Danube.

Day 4: Linz – Aigen – Český Krumlov, approx. 70 km + Train ride

Todays day of your bike tour from Salzburg to Prague starts relaxed with a train ride to Aigen in the Mühlviertel. You will soon cross the border to the Czech Republic by bike. Today you have some climbs to master. However, the immensely beautiful and varied landscape will compensate you. Before you follow the Vltava River towards Český Krumlov, you will have another opportunity to refresh yourself at the Lipno reservoir. Your todays stage destination Český Krumlov, also known under the German name Krumau, belongs to the most beautiful cities of the Czech Republic. A walk through the old town lined with historic buildings in Renaissance and Baroque style will impress you.

Day 5: Český Krumlov – Budweis, approx. 30 km

The fourth stage of your bike tour from Salzburg to Prague is deliberately kept shorter. In Krumlov you can discover a lot. You must see the extensive castle complex high above the Vltava River. It is one of the most important architectural monuments in Central Europe. Full of new impressions, you get on your bike and continue your journey past numerous small farming villages. Once again enjoy the peace and seclusion of nature. Soon you will reach Ceske Budejovice, a city famous for its beer. Take a stroll through the quaint old town before sampling a taste of the delicious beer. Cheers!

Day 6: Budweis – Písek, approx. 70 km

You will leave Ceské Budejovice along the banks of the Vltava River and cycle through the beautiful landscape of South Bohemia. High above the Vltava, you will soon catch sight of Hluboká Castle. It is one of the most beautiful castles in South Bohemia. Originally a castle, it received its present appearance after numerous reconstructions. The English Windsor Castle served as a model. Enjoy a walk through the beautiful castle park and visit the building with its many turrets, battlements and playful details. The last part of your stage takes you through charming river and cultural landscapes along the golden Otava River to Písek.

Day 7: Písek – Sedlčany, approx. 70 km

Along the banks of the Otava River you will first cycle to Zvíkov. At the confluence of the Otava and Vltava rivers, on a promontory, lies the impressive Zvíkov Castle. In the Middle Ages it was one of the most important and hardest to capture castles in Bohemia. Soon you will reach the next highlight in Orlík - the important Gothic castle. The cycling path leads you through the deep green Bohemian forest, small villages and along the Vltava reservoir to your today's stage destination – Sedlčany. Enjoy the evening in the picturesque small town.

Day 8: Sedlčany – Prague, approx. 65 km

Passing numerous idyllic villages, the last stage of your bike tour from Salzburg to Prague takes you through slightly hilly and multifaceted landscapes. You will come across cozy pubs where you can take a break. Taste the typical Czech cuisine and enjoy a refreshing beer. No question about it – the highlight of todays stage is the arrival in the Golden City of Prague. Take a leisurely stroll through the historic city center and explore the winding alleys. Stroll across the Charles Bridge and enjoy the unique view of the city from Prague Castle.

Day 9: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
