Experience an eventful bike tour in the Salzkammergut. A journey that takes you from the gentle hill country through a varied landscape of meadows, moors and lakes to the mighty Hell Mountains. Places like the romantic Mozart village of St. Gilgen and the imperial spa town of Bad Ischl are waiting to be discovered by you. The highlight of your trip is Hallstatt - a place so postcard-perfectly Austrian that it has been recreated on a full scale in China.

# Stages description

### Day 1: Individual arrival at the Wolfgangsee

If you still have some time after your arrival in St. Wolfgang, we recommend wandering along the lakeside. Enjoy this idyllic countryside, the clear water and reflections of the mountains and the wonderful views of the snow-topped peaks. Looking forward to your cycling holiday through Salzkammergut, allow your first evening to come to a pleasant close in the hotel.

# Day 2: Wolfgangsee – Mondsee, approx. 30 km

The first few kilometres to the Mozart village of St. Gilgen are taken at a leisurely pace. "Mozart village" because it has close connections with the family of the famous composer. However, Mozart never actually

spent time here! Leave Wolfgangsee, passing the romantic Krottensee lake, to finally arrive at the southern banks of Mondsee lake. In the village of the same name, you can visit the collegiate church and castle.

## Day 3: Mondsee – Attersee – Traunsee, approx. 60 – 80 km

Always following the banks of Mondsee lake, your cycling holiday through Salzkammergut takes you to Attersee lake. How about a break and a swim in the clear water of Austria's biggest lake? Refreshed, you now cycle along the northern bank and then on through the woods and forest in Aurachtal valley to Traunsee lake. Castle Ort, in Gmunden, is well known as it has been used as a backdrop in films. It is worth a visit. Enjoy the summer air as even the Romans did here.

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#### Day 4: Traunsee - Bad Aussee, approx. 30 km + Train ride

From Ebensee lake, you cycle along level paths alongside Traun lake to Bad Ischl. After a short tour of this historic town, take the train to the "inner" Salzkammergut region, to Bad Aussee. Here, you can decide if you want to do a short cycle ride to Altausee Lake, or if you prefer to walk round the lake, set amidst this lovely mountain landscape.

## Day 5: Excursion to the Ausseer Land, approx. 30 km

On your cycling holiday through Salzkammergut, today, you pedal to Grundlsee lake, which is known by locals as the "Steirisches Meer" (the sea!) - and then on to Toplitzsee lake. Both lakes have something in common: beautiful mountain backdrops and crystal clear water. Go on a tour on one of the romantic boats before you cycle back to Bad Aussee to spend another night there.

## Day 6: Bad Aussee - Hallstätter See - Bad Ischl, approx. 40 km

You set off from one of the world's most beautiful lakeside towns, as Hallstadt was titled by Alexander von Humboldt. If you're not afraid of heights, the route up to the 360 metre high viewing platform

is perfect for breath-taking views from the top. In Bad Ischl, you should make sure you do a guided tour of the Kaiservilla. Next, treat yourself to a slice of Guglhupf in Café Zauner, as Franz Josef I of Austrian and Sissi used to do, too.

## Day 7: Bad Ischl - Wolfgangsee, approx. 35 km

Following the Ischl Ache you pedal back to Lake Wolfgang. Use the remaining time to go on the steepest steam rack and pinion railway in Austria up the 1,783 metre high Schafberg mountain. In clear weather, you have unforgettable panoramic views of the glittering lakes in Salzkammergut and can even trace back your cycle route through Salzkammergut.

### Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.

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
