It is also the many wonderful towns like Bad Reichenhall, Salzburg or Schärding, the mighty abbeys, the longest castle in the world, the narrow gorges and the impressive high mountain reservoirs that make it so wonderfully varied. The Krimml Waterfalls right at the beginning are a magnificent start. Salzburg and Passau offer a cultural contrast and need not be further praised as worthwhile places to stay.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival to Krimml

Plan an early arrival to Krimml, the first highlight of your bike tour from the Hohe Tauern already awaits you here. On a well-designed high-altitude path you walk to the largest waterfalls in Europe: Over three steps the thundering water masses of the Krimml Waterfalls rush 380 meters into the depths. Do not miss this unique natural spectacle.

Day 2: Krimml - Saalfelden, approx. 90 km

The longest stage of the cycle tour from Krimml to Passau starts right at the beginning. You cycle through the magical scenery of the Hohe Tauern National Park and the Oberpinzgau region to Kaprun. Here you can visit the high mountain reservoirs. The dam walls are over 100 metres high and hold 160 million cubic metres of water. A refreshing dip in Lake Zell would of course also be a wonderful way to pass the time. The journey continues across beautiful green meadows, through cosy villages and past the pilgrimage church of Maria Alm to Saalfelden am Steinernen Meer.

Journey to Krimml

Parking in Krimml

- → Public parking near the hotel, about 5 € / day.
- \rightarrow No reservation possible through Radweg-Reisen.

Day 3: Saalfelden – Salzburg, approx. 75 km

Next destination: Salzburg! This will motivate you for the next 75 kilometres, which will take you through the tranquil Pinzgauer Saalachtal valley. Take time to visit the breathtaking natural spectacles such as the Seisenbergklamm gorge, the Lamprechtshöhle cave and the Vorderkaserklamm gorge. It's easy to spend time in the alpine town of Bad Reichenhall in Berchtesgadener Land. Take a walk through the royal spa gardens, to Marzoll Castle or count the 70 fountains in this typically Bavarian small town. Salzburg is not far away. The city, which is so much more than the city of Mozart, will delight you with its cultural offerings.

Day 4: Salzburg – Simbach am Inn, approx. 80 km

Leaving the world of the Alps behind you, you now pedal into the Alpine foothills. The first highlight is the river loop of the Salzach near Oberndorf. The mighty castle complex near Burghausen towers high above the small town's historic centre, which is well worth seeing. Burghausen Castle has been recognised in the Guinness Book of Records as the longest castle in the world. You come to the mouth of the Inn into the Salzach, from here begins the Lower Inn European reserve, which is a breeding ground for many thousands of birds between vast dammed water areas and small alluvial islands. The 15th century pilgrimage church of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary in Simbach, where you are staying overnight, is a beautiful sight.

Day 5: Simbach am Inn – Passau, approx. 70 km

The last stage of the cycle tour from Krimml to Passau awaits. You can look forward to mighty monasteries and pretty towns along the Inn, which will put you in a good mood with their colourful, stucco-decorated town houses. Schärding in particular is a prime example with its Silberzeile, which shines with its colourful facades in pastel shades. The colour of the house facades goes back to the medieval guild colours. A bakery was once blue, a butcher red, innkeepers yellow and green. It's not far along the Inn and you have reached Passau. Take a stroll through the baroque old town or visit the world's largest cathedral organ in St Stephen`s.

Day 6: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
