From Flensburg, your journey leads you to Aarhus, the second biggest city of Denmark. In the middle of this, you cycle to old port cities, villages, that are full of history, attractive landscapes, that are full of dense forests and meadows. Thereby, the Baltic Sea is never far and provides with its mild climate and fine sand beaches refreshing and sun-spoilt moments. Let's go!

Parking in Flensburg

- $\buildrel \rightarrow$ Parking garages in the center, e.g. Parkhaus City, Süderhofenden
 - 4 6, costs approx. 14 Euro / day
- → Hotel parking (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents)

Bike handover

→ Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.

Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- → 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- → Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Flensburg

Flensburg is located to the north of Germany and is therefore an ideal starting point for a cycling tour on the Baltic Sea Cycle Route. After your arrival, stroll through the beautiful alleys and corners of the old town with its typical Flensburg merchants' courtyards.

Day 2: Flensburg - Sønderborg - Åbenrå, approx. 80 km

Near Flensburg you cross the German-Danish border. In Gråsten it is worth taking a first break to see the summer residence of the Danish royal family. Via Sønderborg you continue to Nydam Mose, a bog that was used as a sacrificial site in the Iron Age. In Åbenrå, the old town with its typical burghers' and craftsmen's houses is worth a visit.

Day 3: Åbenrå – Kolding, approx. 95 km

Today you first cycle to Haderslev. The old town, situated on a peninsula, is dominated by the Vor Frue Domkirke - one of the most beautiful Got- hic churches in Denmark. In Kolding, your destination for the day, you will notice the Koldinghus - a castle-like palace that looks back on a long history and houses a museum today. From the tower of the castle, you have a wide view of the city and the Kolding Fjord.

Day 4: Kolding - Vejle, approx. 75 km

You leave Kolding along the Kolding Fjord. After an hour you will reach Gamle Lillebaeltsbro - from the bridge you have a beautiful view over the Little Belt. With a little luck you will see porpoises here. Afterwards you will reach the opposite city Fredericia. Worth seeing is the center

of the city, which was laid out in a checkerboard pattern. On the way to Vejle, Munkebjergsbakken, known as the hardest hill in Denmark, awaits you. But don't worry: with a maximum gradient of around 12% and a length of just over 1 km, the effort is kept within limits. Once you arrive in Veijle, it's worth visiting the windmill, the town's landmark.

Day 5: Vejle - Julsminde - Horsens, approx. 80 / 45 km

There are two routes to choose from today: Take Route 5 along the Vejlefjord to the seaside resort of Juelsminde and continue close to the coast to Hornes. Or follow Route 53 a few kilometers past Vejle to the left inland through hilly and varied countryside characterized by forests and fields (-35 km). In Horsens you can visit a former state prison. Vitus Bering, a celebrity in his town, sailed the Bering Strait, named after him, between America and Asia in the 18th century. Even the city park commemorates him.

Day 6: Horsens - Aarhus, approx. 65 km

Today we continue our journey north. After countless views of the glittering Baltic Sea and with a fresh sea breeze or two, you will reach Norsminde. On the way to Aarhus, Denmark's second largest city, there are numerous opportunities for a longer break at the beach.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.

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
