Day 7	Havneby – Sylt – Niebüll / Schlüttsiel, approx. 60 / 85 km + ferry and train ride
Day 8	Niebüll – Tønder – Flensburg, approx. 100 km

Parking in Flensburg

- Parking garages in the center, e.g. Parkhaus City, Süderhofenden 4 - 6, costs approx. 14 Euro / day
- Hotel parking (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents)

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Flensburg

Flensburg is located to the north of Germany and is therefore an ideal starting point for a cycling tour on the Baltic Sea Cycle Route. After your arrival, stroll through the beautiful alleys and corners of the old town with its typical Flensburg merchants' courtyards.

Day 2: Flensburg – Sønderborg – Åbenrå, approx. 80 km

Near Flensburg you cross the German–Danish border. In Gråsten it is worth taking a first break to see the summer residence of the Danish royal family. Via Sønderborg you continue to Nydam Mose, a bog that was used as a sacrificial site in the Iron Age. In Åbenrå, the old town with its typical burghers' and craftsmen's houses is worth a visit.

Day 3: Åbenrå – Kolding, approx. 95 km

Today you first cycle to Haderslev. The old town, situated on a peninsula, is dominated by the Vor Frue Domkirke - one of the most beautiful Gothic churches in Denmark. In Kolding, your destination for the day, you will notice the Koldinghus - a castle-like palace that looks back on a long history and houses a museum today. From the tower of the castle, you have a wide view of the city and the Kolding Fjord.

Day 4: Kolding – Esbjerg, approx. 80 km

From Kolding Fjord you cycle today to the North Sea! You leave Kolding in a westerly direction and cross southern Jutland with almost no incline until you reach Esbjerg. Founded just over 150 years ago, Esbjerg developed into the most important port city on the Danish North Sea coast.

Day 5: Esbjerg – Fanø – Ribe, approx. 70 km + ferry

A ferry (not included) will take you to the island of Fanø. Today you decide whether you want to explore the island by bike or whether you would rather enjoy a relaxing sunbath on the fine sandy beaches of the west coast. Later, the ferry will take you back to the mainland. Ribe, the oldest city of Denmark with its unequal towers, can be seen from afar.

Day 6: Ribe – Mandø – Havneby (Rømø), approx. 75 km + tractor bus

Today you go to the island of Mandø. At low tide a tractor bus (not included) takes you to the tidal island. The largest sandbank in the Wadden Sea, Koresand, in the southwest of the island, is particularly impressive. You may be lucky enough to see seals sunbathing. Continue on to the island of Rømø. The main town Havneby is your destination today.

Day 7: Havneby – Sylt – Niebüll / Schlüttsiel, approx. 60 / 85 km + ferry and train ride

After a short crossing you reach List on the island of Sylt – Germany's northernmost community. At the harbour you will be tempted by the smell of fish rolls. After a small refreshment you can explore the island on any of the bike routes. The train from Westerland brings you to the mainland.

Day 8: Niebüll – Tønder – Flensburg, approx. 100 km

The last leg of your journey takes you first back to Denmark. A stopover is worthwhile in Møgeltønder. The village is home to Denmark's most beautiful village street. The cobblestone alley lined with thatched-roof houses leads to Schackenborg Castle. That the nearby town of Tønder once became famous for the craft of lace-making is shown by the Drøshes Hus in the historic center. Along the border route you cycle briskly back to Flensburg.

Day 9: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
