### Parking in Odense

- → Q-Park Filosoffen: 250 public parking spaces, unlimited time, cost about 22 euros / day.
- → Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

#### **Bike handover**

→ Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel. Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

#### Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

## **Stages description**

## Day 1: Individual arrival in Odense

Odense, the third largest city in Denmark, is the birthplace of the famous poet and writer Hans Christian Andersen. He is commemorated at every turn in the city, which is over 1000 years old. The Sankt Knuds Kirke in the center reflects the prosperity of the city in the Middle Ages and is one of the most important Gothic buildings in Denmark.

## Day 2: Odense – Fåborg, approx. 50 km

Along the river Odense Å the route takes you through the suburbs out of Odense. In Brobyværk you should plan a break. You can eat well at Brobyværk Kro and after the stage has been flat so far, you will soon reach the so-called "Funen Alps". Through a beautiful nature reserve, the route here is hilly through the glacial moraine landscape to Fåborg.

# Day 3: Fåborg – Svendborg / Troense, approx. 35 / 40 km

Almost close to the coast you cycle to Svendborg, a traditional seafaring town. Visit Anne Hvides Gård, the oldest building in Svendborg. Or how about an evening stroll along the harbour? At Sejlskibsbroen, old woo- den boats and sailing ships are anchored and exude a maritime atmo- sphere.

# Day 4: Excursion to the island of Ærø, approx. 35 – 60 km + ferry rides

Today you will travel by ferry (included) to the Danish South Seas. Your first destination is Ærøskøbing, the oldest town on the island. You are free to decide the island completely or only the eastern or western

half of the island. half of the island. Whether the seafaring town of Marstal, the cliffs of Voderup Klint, the hunting lodge of Søbygaard, the lighthouse of Skjoldnæs or the beautiful Ærøskøbing – you will experience a relaxing cycling day. Depending on your wishes, the route can be shortened. The ferry (included) will take you back to Svendborg.

# Day 5: Svendborg – Nyborg, approx. 55 km

On the way to Nyborg you have the opportunity to stop at one of the numerous beaches. With the sea and the Great Belt Bridge in view, the oldest royal castle in Denmark awaits you in Nyborg. It served as the residence of the Danish kings for many centuries.

## Day 6: Nyborg – Odense, approx. 50 km

In Kerteminde it is worth visiting the marine research center Fjord & Bælt. It will bring you closer to the marine ecosystem and you can experience porpoises and seals up close. Or how about a longer break at the beach? In Odense, we recommend a boat trip on the Odense Å, which takes you past many sights.

# Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
