Your tour

This round trip starts in Sønderborg on the Flensburg Fjord. You will cycle along the Jutland coast of the Little Belt and reach the island of Funen, which will impress you with its lush nature and beautiful castles. Odense, the hometown of the fairytale writer Hans Christian Andersen, is just as impressive. You will then set sail for the "Danish South Sea", famous for its numerous islands. From Fåborg, you are only a stone's throw away from the island of Als, which you will get to know on your way back to Sønderborg.

Parking in Sønderborg

- → Free parking on public roads
- → Hotel parking spaces (available in some hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

→ Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.

Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- → 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- → Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual Arrival in Sønderborg

Your cycling holiday in Denmark begins in Sønderborg on the Flensburg Fjord, not far from Germany. Visit the castle of the same name, one of the oldest royal castles in Jutland, built directly on the water.

Day 2: Sønderborg – Åbenrå, approx. 35 km

Today's route is relaxed and takes you through forests and wide fields over the Sundewitt peninsula. A visit to Sandbjerg Castle, one of the most elegant palaces in Southern Jutland, is worthwhile. Åbenrå captivates with its charming town houses and craftsmen's houses.

Day 3: Åbenrå – Christiansfeld, approx. 40 / 70 km

Today you cycle first to Haderslev. The medieval old town on Hadersleven Dam has many cafés and a walk along the medieval reservoir. Back on the saddle, you cycle comfortably through the quiet area to Christ- iansfeld.

Day 4: Christiansfeld - Middelfart, approx. 45 / 65 km

After leaving Christiansfeld, you cycle through the wooded region to Kolding. From afar you can already see the massive tower of the old royal castle Koldinghus. Passing Kolding Fjord and via Skærbæk, you cross the Little Belt just before you reach your destination for the day, Middelfart.

Day 5: Middelfart - Odense, approx. 60 / 65 km

Visit the Henner Friisers Hus in Middelfart. It is considered one of the most beautiful half-timbered houses in Denmark. You cycle along the coast to Strib with its small lighthouse. Take a short break on the beach: with a bit of luck you will see porpoises. It continues through idyllic landscapes until you reach Odense, the third largest city in the country. If you want to shorten the stage, follow route 6 out of Middelfart to Odense today (- 7 km).

Day 6: Odense - Fåborg, approx. 50 km

Along the river Odense Å the route takes you through the suburbs out of Odense. In Brobyværk you should plan a break. You can eat well at Brobyværk Kro and after the stage has been flat so far, you will soon reach the so-called "Funen Alps". Through a beautiful nature reserve, the route here is hilly through the glacial moraine landscape to Fåborg.

Day 7: Fåborg – Sønderborg, approx. 45 / 35 km + ferry

With its narrow, cobbled streets, Fåborg is one of the oldest and most idyllic small towns in Denmark. In Bøjden you board the ferry to the island of Als and then cycle via the harbour town of Høruphav to Sønderborg.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
