

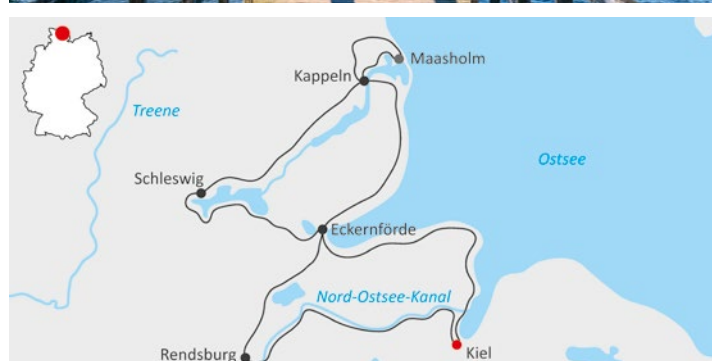
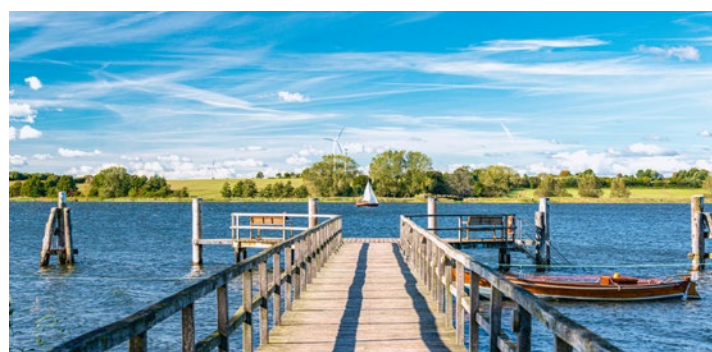
Cycle tour along the Schlei

Your tour

This round trip takes you to the Kiel Canal, the Schlei and the Baltic Sea. You start in Kiel, the capital of Schleswig-Holstein, get to know the Rendsburg High Bridge, explore the former royal seat of Schleswig and walk in the footsteps of the Vikings in the open-air museum Haithabu. Along the Schlei you will come across small, pretty fishing villages such as Kappeln and Maasholm, discover one or two stately manor houses on the way back to Kiel and enjoy a refreshing swim in the Baltic Sea in Eckernförde. Let's go!

Journey to Kiel

- Closest airport: Hamburg, Billund
- Train station: Kiel
- Ferry: Göteborg – Kiel, Oslo – Kiel, Klaipėda – Kiel

Parking in Kiel

- Car Park ZOB Kiel, costs approx. 10 Euro / day
- Car Park CAP, costs approx. 10 Euro / day

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Kiel

Your cycle tour begins in Kiel, the capital of Schleswig-Holstein. Founded in the 13th century, the city developed into Germany's northernmost major city in the following centuries. After checking in at your hotel, grab your bike and explore the city centre as well as the promenade along the Kiel Fjord with its many ships.

Day 2: Kiel – Rendsburg, approx. 40 km

Today you will get to know the Kiel Canal! Marvel at the Rendsburg, one of the longest railway bridges in Germany. At the foot of the bridge is the Rendsburg ship welcoming facility. Passing ships are greeted by the dipping of the respective national flag and the playing of the national anthem. Only a stone's throw away is Rendsburg's historic old town.

Day 3: Rendsburg – Eckernförde – Schleswig, approx. 50 km

You leave the Kiel Canal behind and cycle first towards the Baltic Sea. You pass Lake Wittensee in the middle of the hilly Hüttener Berge Nature Park and reach Eckernförde. Visit the old town before continuing on to Schleswig. One of the landmarks is the St. Peter's Cathedral, visible from afar, from where you have a magnificent view of the town.

Day 4: Schleswig – Kappeln, approx. 40 / 50 km

Today the Schlei will accompany you on your trip. On your way from Schleswig to the North Sea you will pass many small and pretty villages, such as Arnis, the smallest town in Germany. Take a break here and enjoy the maritime flair of the town. A little further down the road you will arrive in Kappeln, where you can have a look at the largest Dutch windmill of state, the herring fence, and the museum harbour.

Day 5: Excursion to Maasholm, approx. 30 km

First we go to the small fishing village of Maasholm. Not far from the mouth of the Schleim, Maasholm was originally an island. Today the village is connected to the mainland. Take a boat trip to Lotseninsel, a peninsula whose southern end is marked by a lighthouse painted green and white. Treat yourself to a longer break before returning to Kappeln via Maasholm.

Day 6: Kappeln – Eckernförde, approx. 45 km

The Baltic Sea resort Damp is easily accessible via the peninsula Schwansen. There you can relax in a beach chair along the sandy 4 km beach. After your break you continue your journey through unspoilt nature, past old avenues, over gentle hills, and lush green forests to Eckernförde. Spend the evening at the beautiful and idyllic harbour promenade. Try the freshly caught fish in one of the cosy restaurants.

Day 7: Eckernförde – Kiel, approx. 50 km

Not far from the Baltic Sea, you cycle on the last stage to Glücksburg. The town on the Flensburg Fjord is the northernmost town in Germany. In Flensburg, just a few kilometres away, you will reach your destination. The town looks back on a history of over 750 years, which is reflected in numerous sights. Alternatively, you can shorten the route from Glücksburg to Flensburg by boat.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
