Your tour

From the old Hanseatic town of Lübeck your cycle tour takes you along the Baltic Coast cycle path to Heiligenhafen. Shortly after Heiligenhafen you leave the coast to explore the varied countryside further inland. Enjoy the peace and quiet of this gently hilly area. From Eutin, the „Weimar of the North“, take a trip to Plön, where going by boat on the Great Plön Lake is something not to be missed. The countryside is very varied here with steep cliffs, white sandy beaches and the hilly, fertile green of the hinterland.

Day 6	Eutin – Lübeck, approx. 55 km

Journey to Lübeck

- Closest airports: Hamburg
- Train station: Lübeck Hauptbahnhof (main station)

Parking in Lübeck

- Public car parks, cost approx. 10 EUR / day
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Lübeck

Your bike tour starts in the old, magnificent Hanseatic city, which was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987. If you talk about Holstentor, marzipan and Thomas Mann, Lübeck immediately comes to mind. You should not miss a fish roll as a prelude to your vacation.

Day 2: Lübeck – Neustadt in Holstein, approx. 45 km

In Travemünde you can take a break to see Germany's oldest lighthouse. The seaside resorts of Timmendorfer Strand and Scharbeutz have lovely sandy beaches and invite you to go in for a refreshing dip in the sea. Today you'll have frequent views of the Lübeck and Neustadt Bays.

Day 3: Neustadt – Heiligenhafen, approx. 60 km

Today, you cycle along Mecklenburg Bay to the seaside resort of Grömitz, where you can walk along the 400-m long pier. On the 8 kms of sandy beach you should find a place to stop and spend some time and maybe go for a swim. Via Grossenbrode you cycle to Heiligenhafen with its pretty historic quarter and a remarkable salt warehouse.

Day 4: Heiligenhafen – Eutin, approx. 60 km

You'll still be on the Baltic Coast cycle path up to Sehlendorf, but then you pedal into the heart of „Holstein's Switzerland“. The countryside features many lakes, gentle hills and expansive deciduous woods. The

route is quite hilly, along the „Holsteinische-Schweiz“ cycle path via Blekendorf, Benz and Sielbeck to Eutin, the cultural hub of „Holstein's Switzerland“.

Day 5: Excursion to Plön, approx. 40 km + boat trip or approx. 50 km

From Eutin you cycle the short section to Plön, named after the lake. From here you cycle along Prince Island, sometimes only 30 meter in width – a peninsula in Great Plön Lake. It's one of 16 lakes in this urban area. You cross by boat to the climatic spa resort of Bosau (not included). From here you cycle leisurely back to your starting point.

Day 6: Eutin – Lübeck, approx. 55 km

You cycle through Holstein's Switzerland back to the Baltic Coast, to reach Haffkrug. From there you continue along the coast to Travemünde and from there back to Lübeck, the old and gracious Hanseatic town.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
