Your tour

Building giant castles at the beach, jumping over waves and splashing in the sea, going with a ship on a pirate tour, observing robs and cycling through the ghost forest – all of this expects you on this one-week-long bike trip at the Baltic Sea. For sure, the ride with the steam train Mollie will be a special experience for your children. The lengths of the stages are made for children and the cities Lübeck, Wismar and Rostock are interesting for the whole family.

Journey to Lübeck

- Closest airports: Hamburg
- Train station: Lübeck Hauptbahnhof (main station)

Parking in Lübeck

- Public car parks, cost approx. 10 EUR / day
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Return trip to Lübeck

- Optional with a minibus (on Saturdays & Sundays): Duration approx. 2.5 hours, must be stated when booking.
- On your own by train, connections every 1 – 2 hours, duration approx. 3 hours, 1 – 2 changes.

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Lübeck

Your bike tour starts in the old, magnificent Hanseatic city, which was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987. If you talk about Holstentor, marzipan and Thomas Mann, Lübeck immediately comes to mind. You should not miss a fish roll as a prelude to your vacation.

Day 2: Lübeck – Gross Schwansee / Boltenhagen, approx. 20 / 30 km + boat trips (Cat A), Lübeck – Hohen Schönberg, approx. 20 km + boat trips (Cat B)

You start the day with a boat trip on the Trave to Travemünde. There you can visit Germany's oldest lighthouse before continuing on the first section along the Baltic Coast through Brooker Wald nature reserve to Boltenhagen. From the cliffs you have views over the entire bay. You either spend the night in Boltenhagen, or in Gross Schwansee.

Day 3: Day on the beach in Boltenhagen,

The Baltic spa resort of Boltenhagen is known for its 5 km long sandy beach - the whole family will enjoy. Why not hop straight into the water? If you spent the night in Hohen Schönberg, it's only a short cycle trip of approx. 10 km to Boltenhagen. If you prefer more cultural entertainment, we can recommend visiting Bothmer Castle in Klütz. The Baroque castle with the wonderful Feston avenue leading up to it is quite spectacular and a great photo opportunity.

Day 4: Boltenhagen – Wismar, approx. 45 / 30 km,

Today we will travel mostly along the shore to the beautiful Hanseatic city of Wismar. Here, after an extensive tour through the historic old town, a detour to the harbor is worthwhile.

Day 5: Day trip to Poel Island, up to approx. 25 km + boat trips,

A boat takes you right from Wismar to Poel island. Once there, follow the circular tour around the entire island, which tempts you with long, beautiful sandy beaches and a dip into the cool wet blue. You can return either by boat or leave Poel by its dam by bike and cycle the 10 km to Wismar.

Day 6: Wismar – Kühlungsborn / Bad Doberan, approx. 45 km,

On the way to Kühlungsborn, cliffs and beautiful beaches alternate along your path, offering great views or great swimming. If you're staying in Bad Doberan, the train „Molli“, a steam-driven train, takes you there from Kühlungsborn.

Day 7: Kühlungsborn / Bad Doberan – Warnemünde / Rostock, approx. 20 – 40 km + train ride,

If you stayed in Kühlungsborn, you start today with a trip with „Molli“ to Heiligendamm. On the way to Warnemünde, you cycle through the „haunted forest“ - woods that got their name because of the weird and wonderful shapes of the trees. You soon reach Warnemünde, where you can relax on the widest expanse of beach on the Baltic coast. If you are staying in Rostock, just follow the Warnow river into town.

Day 8: Stay in Rostock / Warnemünde

Today you're spoiled for choice in Warnemünde and Rostock. Would you like to bring your cycling holiday to an end on the beach or experience seals at close in the research centre, Hohe Düne? A great experience for young and old is a trip to Rostock, where you can watch the gigantic cruise ships entering Rostock harbour.

Day 9: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
