Your tour

Starting from Husum – the hometown of Theodor Storm – you cycle along the coastline, which is characterized by beautiful views of the North Sea. You visit the North Sea islands of Sylt, Rømø and Fanø as well as the Hallig Hooe - each unique in its own right. Surrounded by the Wadden Sea exclusive nature experiences, miles of sandy beaches and idyllic moments await you on the small islets. On the way to your destination Esbjerg, you also get to know Ribe, the oldest city in Denmark.

- Closest airports: Hamburg, Billund
- Train station: Husum

Parking in Husum

- Harbour car park: Am Binnenhafen, 470 parking spaces, unlimited, costs approx. 8 euros / day.
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Husum

The small town of Husum is shaped by the interplay of the tides. The North Sea reaches right into the inland harbour. Observe the ebb and flow of the tide in the middle of the town. Stroll through the narrow streets and alleys and marvel at the picturesque, differently coloured gabled houses.

Day 2: Husum – Schlüttsiel / Dagebüll, approx. 45 / 55 km

The first stage of your cycle tour to Sylt takes you - always along the dyke - through North Friesland. You cycle along the North Sea Cycle Route through numerous nature reserves and bird sanctuaries. You are sure to come across the numerous sheep that romp around on the dikes. On your left, you look out over the Schleswig-Holstein Wadden Sea National Park with its unique Halligen islands. Treat yourself to a break on the dyke or take a detour along the flagstone path to Hamburger Hallig for a cup of coffee and enjoy the great view before you reach your stage destination.

Day 3: Excursion to the island of Hooge, approx. 10 / 25 km + boat trip

The Halligen are small marshland islands in the Wadden Sea that are completely flooded several times a year. Thanks to the terps - artificial embankments - the islands can be inhabited all year round. You and your bike take the ferry to Hallig Hooge, the largest Hallig in the North Sea. In the storm tide cinema you can experience a typical landfall on a large screen in an impressive way. Enjoy the unique landscape before taking the ferry back to the mainland.

Day 4: Schlüttsiel – Sylt – Havneby, approx. 60 km + train + ferry

First of all, you and your bikes will board the train today and travel over the Hindenburg Dam to the Queen of the North Sea. The cycling tour on Sylt can be arranged according to your wishes. The Hörnum

lighthouse awaits you in the south of the island. But Sylt is also perfect for a relaxing day at the beach. If you have not treated yourself to a fish sandwich or a slice of Frisian cake yet, you should use today to do so! Then take the ferry to the Danish island of Rømø.

Day 5: Free Day on the island of Rømø

How you spend today on the largest sandy beach in Northern Europe is entirely up to you. You can explore the island by bike or on foot. Likewise a trip with a sand yacht. Or would you prefer an extensive and relaxed sunbath?

Day 6: Havneby – Ribe, approx. 45 km

Back on the Danish mainland, you can see the disparate towers of Ribe Cathedral from afar. Ribe is the oldest town in the country and was an important port and trading town in the Viking Age and the Middle Ages.

Day 7: Ribe – Esbjerg, approx. 35 km + detour to the island Fanø

Back at the sea, you first climb the Vandtårnet - landmark of the young town of Esbjerg. The viewing platform offers a magnificent view of the city all the way to the island of Fanø, your next excursion destination. After a short crossing (not included), with a little luck you might have the opportunity to discover washed up amber. The sculpture group „Man by the Sea“ can be admired at Sædding Strand in Esbjerg.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
