Your tour

On your tour you will visit three wonderful North Sea islands that could hardly be more different: Hallig Hooge, the largest of the German Halligs, Sylt, the most fashionable and well-known German island, and its Danish sister island Rømø, which has a far quieter, more idyllic and down-to-earth feel. Accordingly, you will spend the night on Rømø in an authentic "Kro", a Danish inn.

Journey to Husum

- → Closest airports: Hamburg, Billund
- → Train station: Husum

Parking in Husum

- → Harbour car park: Am Binnenhafen, 470 parking spaces, unlimited, costs approx. 8 euros / day.
- → Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents).

Bike handover

→ Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel. Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

→ Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- → 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- → Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Husum

The small town of Husum is shaped by the interplay of the tides. The North Sea reaches right into the inland harbour. Observe the ebb and flow of the tide in the middle of the town. Stroll through the narrow streets and alleys and marvel at the picturesque, differently coloured gabled houses.

Day 2: Husum – Schlüttsiel / Dagebüll, approx. 45 – 60 km

The first stage of your cycle tour to Sylt takes you - always along the dyke - through North Friesland. You cycle along the North Sea Cycle Route through numerous nature reserves and bird sanctuaries. You are sure to come across the numerous sheep that romp around on the dikes. On your left, you look out over the Schleswig-Holstein Wadden Sea National Park with its unique Halligen islands. Treat yourself to a break on the dyke or take a detour along the flagstone path to Hamburger Hallig for a cup of coffee and enjoy the great view before you reach your stage destination.

Day 3: Excursion to the island of Hooge, approx. 10 / 25 km + boat trip

The Halligen are small marshland islands in the Wadden Sea that are completely flooded several times a year. Thanks to the terps - artificial embankments - the islands can be inhabited all year round. You and your bike take the ferry to Hallig Hooge, the largest Hallig in the North Sea. In the storm tide cinema you can experience a typical landfall on a large screen in an impressive way. Enjoy the unique landscape before taking the ferry back to the mainland.

Day 4: Schlüttsiel – Sylt – Havneby, approx. 60 km + train + ferry

First of all, you and your bikes will board the train today and travel over the Hindenburg Dam to the Queen of the North Sea. The cycling tour on Sylt can be arranged according to your wishes. The Hörnum lighthouse awaits you in the south of the island. But Sylt is also perfect for a relaxing day at the beach. If you haven't treated yourself to a fish sandwich or a slice of Frisian cake yet, you should use today to do so! Then take the ferry to the Danish island of Rømø.

Day 5: Havneby – Højer / Tønder, approx. 40 / 55 km

Discover the beauty and tranquillity of Denmark's southernmost and largest North Sea island today. On the popular holiday island of Rømø, one thing is particularly impressive: the beach! The sandy beach is the longest and widest of its kind in all of Northern Europe and is also easily accessible by bike. You then reach the mainland via an approximately ten-kilometre-long causeway. Once in Tønder, enjoy the evening in the town with its well-preserved patrician houses in Baroque and Rococo style.

Day 6: Tønder – Niebüll / Schlüttsiel, approx. 30 – 65 km

You leave Denmark on the North Sea Coast Cycle Route. Just over the border, it is worth visiting the Emil Nolde Museum in Neukirchen. The exhibition offers insights into the life and work of one of the most important Expressionist painters. You cycle on quiet paths through meadows and fields to Niebüll. Once there, we recommend a visit to the Natural History Museum. You will spend the night in Niebüll or Schlüttsiel.

Day 7: Niebüll – Husum, approx. 55 / 40 km

From Dagebüll you cycle directly along the coast. On the way, make a detour to the Hamburger Hallig (+ 8 km). The small peninsula is very easy to reach by bike. At the end of the Hallig, an inn invites you to a longer and more scenic stay. In your destination for the day, Husum, the town's most famous son, Theodor Storm, is commemorated at every turn. The writer once described Husum as a gray town by the sea. Far from it, because the colorful and lively harbor town is neither gray nor drab.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
