Parking in Freiburg

- Public parking garages: Parking garage no. 13 Karlsbau, Auf der Zinnen 1, 650 parking spaces, unlimited time, costs approx. 75 euros / week; Parking garage no. 15 Schlossberg, Schlossberggring 14, 430 parking spaces, unlimited time, costs approx. 90 euros / week; Underground parking garage Am Bahnhof P4, 278 parking spaces, max. 30 days, costs approx. 20 euros / day

Bike handover

- Arrival: Guests' rental bikes will be available at the arrival hotel.
Departure: The guests leave the bikes at the last hotel. If an e-bike has been rented, the battery, charger and key must be returned to the reception.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Freiburg

The tour begins in Freiburg, Germany's warmest town. Look out for the „Bächle“ – the small water-filled rills along most streets and alleyways that give this town its own special flair.

Day 2: Freiburg – Breisach / Vogelgrun / Vogtsburg, approx. 30 – 45 km

Get in the saddle and set off on the first stage of your cycle tour in the Kaiserstuhl. Get out of the hustle and bustle of the city and into the idyllic landscape. You cycle along vineyards and through beautiful little villages. Discover the charming old towns of Breisach and Burkheim. Taste the sun-drenched wines of the region, plus a portion of ‚Leberle‘ with ‚Brägele‘ and you'll be fortified for the onward journey.

Day 3: Circular tour around the Kaiserstuhl, approx. 55 km

Not far from the floodplains of the Rhine, your cycle route today first takes you through the vineyards of the Kaiserstuhl. vineyards of the Kaiserstuhl. Expect some uphill stretches for the first few kilometres climbs. You will be rewarded with a magnificent view over the wine region the wine region. Afterwards you cycle on pleasantly flat paths through numerous small winegrowing communities. Today's stage of the cycle tour in the Kaiserstuhl brings you back to the starting point of the day.

Day 4: Excursion to Alsace and Colmar, approx. 50 / 70 km

You cross the Rhine by bike and thus also the border to France. Neuf-Brisach is the town of the Sun King. A tour of the octagonal, architecturally unique town will also fascinate you. Then you cycle

to charming Colmar. Old, well-preserved half-timbered houses and flower-decked bridges add to the bridges add to the dreamy atmosphere of the Petite Venise district.

Day 5: Vogtsburg – Müllheim / Badenweiler, approx. 30 – 50 km

The Rhine flows northwards. You follow the river - but in the opposite direction. Soon you reach the first bathing resorts. Here on the edge of the Black Forest, healing waters emerge from the mountains and favour the operation of thermal baths, some of which have been in use since Roman times. Visit a Roman bathing ruin before you can enjoy the pleasant thermal the pleasant thermal water in the Cassiopeia Therme (not included).

Day 6: Badenweiler – Freiburg, approx. 45 / 40 km

You cycle through the vineyards of the Markgräflerland - up to the right the Black Forest and to the left the Vosges Mountains. Freiburg is Germany's warmest and most southern city. It has its own particular charm - look out for the small water-filled rills along most streets and alleyways. From the Schlossberg, you have a great view over the town and the surrounding area.

Day 7: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
