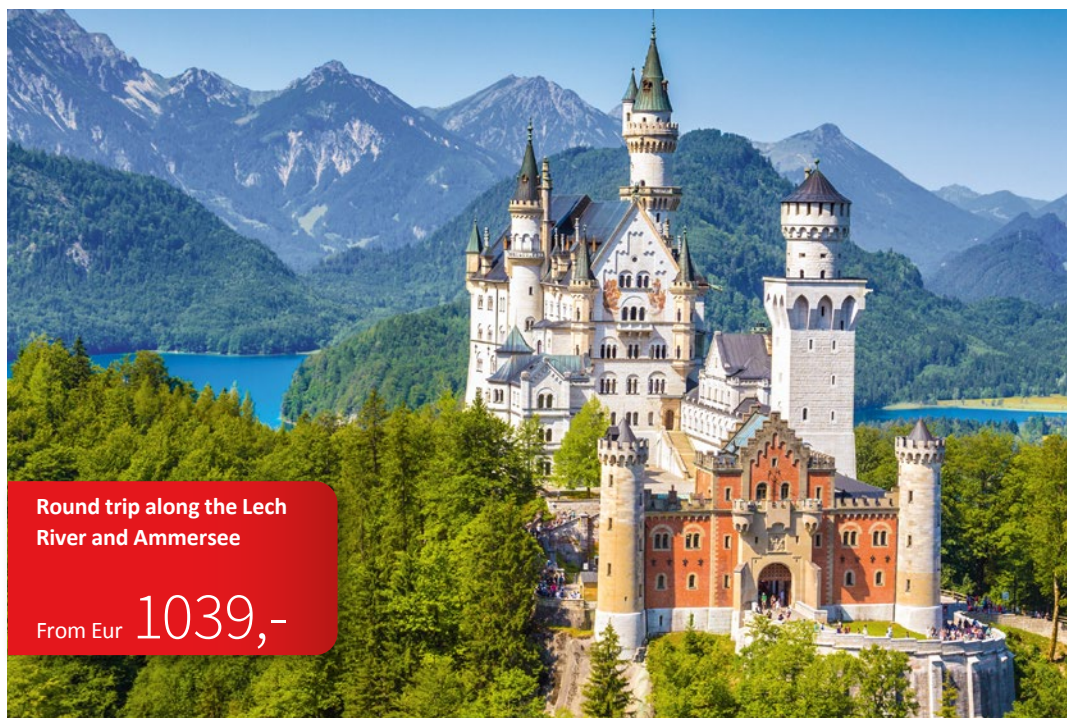


Cycle Tour from Augsburg to Neuschwanstein Castle

Your tour

The journey takes you through the Allgäu and the Upper Bavarian foothills of the Alps. Accompanied by magnificent meadow landscapes, deep blue lakes and dreamy villages, you will experience one of the most popular holiday regions in Germany. Visit the Andechs Monastery, visible from afar, treat yourself to an extensive bathing break at the Ammersee and Staffelsee lakes, cross the Pfaffenwinkel, stroll through the fairytale castles of Neuschwanstein and Hohenschwangau, enjoy the view over the Lech valley and try a delicious plum cake in Augsburg.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Augsburg

Your cycle tour to Neuschwanstein Castle begins in Augsburg, the city of the Fuggers with its famous Fuggerei social housing complex from 1516. The name of the city dates back to Roman times when the city was founded in 15 BC as Augusta Vindelicorum, making it one of the oldest cities in Germany. Along with numerous museums and Fugger style houses, there are also a number of important buildings such as the Heilig-Geist-Spital with its well-known Puppenkiste marionette-theatre.

Day 2: Augsburg – Wörthsee, approx. 65 km

On your first day of cycling you will receive some information in the morning about your tour and bicycles will be distributed (if booked). Then you will set off cycling through fertile meadows and through rural Bavarian villages along the shores of the Ammersee. There will be a number of inviting guesthouses with sunny terraces and shady gardens along the lakeshore which are perfect for a break. You will then continue towards the Wörthsee. Glacial erosion formed this lake during the Ice Age.

Day 3: Wörthsee – Murnau, approx. 60 km

From Wörthsee you will cycle today along the Pilsensee and Ammersee lakes through a beautiful landscape. You should have your first stop in Andechs, where the monastery and castle with its pilgrim church are real tourist magnets. You will have the opportunity to swim towards the end of today's tour on the Staffel- and Riegsee lakes. Murnau, directly situated on the Staffelsee, was covered by a 600 m thick ice sheet during the last Ice Age.

Day 4: Murnau – Füssen / Schwangau, approx. 60 km

Today you will leave both small lakes behind you and along the route to Füssen you will be accompanied by the romantic landscape of the alpine meadows and great panoramas. The famous Wieskirche is situated en route to Steingaden and is a perfect example of the Bavarian Rococo style. You will then reach Füssen which is situated on the Romantic Road and has an attractive castle and the Sankt Mang Monastery.

Day 5: Füssen – Schongau, approx. 50 km

After only a few kilometres you will come across the royal castles of Hohenschwangau and Neuschwanstein. You continue cycling along the Lech through impressive landscapes until you reach the world-famous Wieskirche church near Steingaden. In Schongau, you can experience a touch of the Middle Ages in the beautiful old town.

Day 6: Schongau – Landsberg am Lech, approx. 35 km

You leave Schongau and follow the Romantic Road through the Pfaffenwinkel. Once you have arrived in Landsberg am Lech, there is much to see. Numerous rustic inns invite you to try Upper Bavarian or Swabian specialities in the evening.

Day 7: Landsberg am Lech – Augsburg, approx. 45 km

First you cycle via Kaufering am Lech to Königsbrunn. Those who decide for the longer stage pay a visit to the ducal town of Friedberg. With the shorter option, you have more time in the Fugger city Augsburg. You can also visit the house where Bertolt Brecht was born or the Roman Museum. The city's beer tradition dates back to the Middle Ages.

Day 8: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
