On our journey along the Moselle Cycle Route in Rhineland-Palatinate, you will get to know Germany's oldest wine region. A true region of pleasure that enjoys an excellent reputation far beyond the banks of the Moselle. The sun-drenched wines in particular will make you go into raptures. But there are also sights worth seeing on our trip along the Moselle Cycle Route. You start in Trier. The city knows how to impress with remarkable buildings from more than 2000 years of city history. The destination of our tour is Koblenz. The city is dominated by the Deutsches Eck and Ehrenbreitenstein Fortress, which towers over the Rhine. On our journey along the Moselle Cycle Route, there is much to see and even more to experience - and all in a relaxed manner, without any notable ascents and on cycle paths of very good quality.

<b>Day 5</b>	Cochem – Coblenz, approx. 50 km and individual departure

## Stages description

### Day 1: Individual arrival in Treves

Welcome to the Moselle! Founded more than 2000 years ago, the Roman heritage of the oldest German city can be felt at every corner. A special testimony to the Roman era is the Porta Nigra, the Black Gate. Trier's landmark is the ideal starting point for an extensive exploration of the city. Visit the Imperial Baths, the Roman Bridge, the Trier Cathedral and gain insight into the life and work of probably the most famous Trier man in the Karl Marx House.

### Day 2: Treves – Piesport, approx. 50 km

In the Moselle Valley you will come into contact with the Roman and the winegrowing culture of the region. Today you will be able to view a very special relic from Ancient times: The Rustica in Mehring was

reconstructed according to original plans and showcases the Roman way of life. In Trittenheim, wine lovers and connoisseurs are in for treat as you can stroll around the informative vineyard path.

### Day 3: Piesport – Traben-Trarbach, approx. 40 km

In the timber-framed small town of Bernkastel-Kues you will be able to admire the very pretty Market Square before continuing on to Zeltingen, a traditional winegrowing village with monastery gardens in the Moselle Baroque style. Continuing on along the Moselle you will pass through Kröv with its famous Kröver Nacktarsch vineyard before coming to Traben-Trarbach. This small town is a gem filled with buildings in the Classical and Jugendstil styles.

**Day 4: Traben-Trarbach – Cochem, approx. 55 km**

Passing through Zell, which is well-known for its Zeller Schwarze Katz, you will continue on to Beilstein, the Sleeping Beauty of the Moselle. The village is really similar to that of a storybook landscape! The village has changed little over the past few centuries, retaining its medieval flair. Soon you will reach Cochem, which is surrounded by rolling, wooded hills.

**Day 5: Cochem – Coblenz, approx. 50 km and individual departure**

Final spurt! You follow the Moselle in a relaxed manner and reach Treis-Karden. The white Moselle cathedral is the most important church between Trier and Koblenz and dominates the town's skyline. Eltz Castle is just a stone's throw away from Treis-Karden, slightly off the Moselle. It is one of the most beautiful and impressive castles in Germany. Back on the Moselle cycle path in Rhineland-Palatinate, you reach Koblenz. Before your trip ends in Koblenz and you depart without an overnight stay, pay a visit to the Deutsches Eck and Ehrenbreitensstein Fortress. We are happy to extend your stay in Trier or Koblenz with an extra night.
