Your tour

From your hotel in Trier, you set off on various day tours by bike. You will get to know the three rivers Saar, Moselle and Kyll, whose river valleys all have their own unique flair. Vineyards line your path and small wine villages invite you to taste the local grape varieties. On this tour, you can largely determine the itinerary yourself by deciding in the morning which course of the river you would like to cycle along, depending on your mood. Alternatively, if the weather doesn't cooperate at all, you can simply explore the charming city of Trier or read a book.

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Treves

Welcome to the Moselle! Founded more than 2000 years ago, the Roman heritage of the oldest German city can be felt at every corner. A special testimony to the Roman era is the Porta Nigra, the Black Gate. Trier's landmark is the ideal starting point for an extensive exploration of the city. Visit the Imperial Baths, the Roman Bridge, the Trier Cathedral and gain insight into the life and work of probably the most famous Trier man in the Karl Marx House.

Day 2: Excursion to Saarburg, approx. 50 km

Today you first follow the Upper Moselle and the Saar. Your excursion destination Saarburg looks back on over 1000 years of history. Part of this history is the castle ruins above the town. It is one of the oldest hilltop castles in western Germany. From the viewing platforms you have a marvellous view over the Saar valley. At the heart of Saarburg is a 20 metre high waterfall, the sound of which can be heard from afar. It was created in the Middle Ages to utilise water power to drive mill wheels. You cycle back to Trier via Tawern and Konz.

Day 3: Excursion to Bitburg, approx. 50 km + train ride

Take the train (ticket not included) to Bitburg-Erdorf in comfort. You can look forward to a guided tour of the brewery and learn more about the brewing process. Of course, you will not be denied a tasting. Then grab your bike and explore the tranquil Kyll valley. In the narrow valley, you will always cycle close to the course of the river through fascinating natural landscapes. Enjoy the peace and quiet and the marvellous panorama! The Kyll flows into the Moselle at Ehrang. For the last few kilometres, you will be accompanied by the Moselle all the way to Trier.

Day 4: Excursion to Piesport, approx. 50 km + boat trip

In the morning, it's time to cast off! The boat takes you on a leisurely cruise along the Moselle. You will have enough time to take in the panorama from the deck until you reach Piesport. In Piesport, visit the Roman wine press from the 3rd century before you start pedalling. You will soon reach Neumagen-Dhron, the oldest wine village in Germany. The little village is perfect for a lunch break. Well fortified, the route takes you along an educational wine trail. Learn more about the local

grape varieties and sample a good drop or two. Back in Trier, a short tour of the city is on the programme. Here you will learn more about the numerous monuments and the history of the city.

Day 5: Trier – Perl – Trier, approx. 50 km + Train ride and individual departure

Before you leave Trier for home, we recommend a cycle tour up the Moselle. By train (ticket not included), you will reach the tranquil town of Perl in the border triangle of Germany, France and Luxembourg

in around an hour. From here, the Moselle serves as the border between Germany and Luxembourg. The panorama could hardly be more beautiful, with vineyards rising up on both sides of the river. You quickly return to Trier via Konz. Would you like to stay longer in Trier? No problem! We are happy to extend your stay with an extra night. We are sure that you will remember the star cycle tour from Trier for a long time to come!

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
