Itinerary

Your tour:

Three highlights link up the stages of this tour through Germany's south west: possibly the most beautiful part of Lake Constance with the Hõri peninsular and the medieval towns of Konstanz and Stein am Rhein, Europe's biggest water fall in Schaffhausen and the wild romance of the Danube valley with its ancient rock formations.

Day 1: Individual arrival in Constance

Take the opportunity to visit the island of Mainau, wander through Constance's old town or visit the aquariums in the Sea Life Center and go to the Archaeological Museum.

Day 2: Constance – Schaffhausen, approx. 60 km

Following the side of Lake Constance, you pedal to Stein am Rhein with its frescoed, medieval houses. Switching several times between Germany and Switzerland you reach the canton's capital, Schaffhausen. The town, whose citizens competed with each other in building gables on their houses, is overlooked by Munot fort.

Day 3: Schaffhausen – Rhine Falls – Radolfzell, approx. 55 km

After breakfast, cycle the short distance to the Rhine Falls, one of Europe's biggest waterfalls. From there, you cycle back to Stein am Rhein and then along the Hõri peninsula where Otto Dix and Hermann Hesse used to live and work. Today's destination is the former Imperial and now spa town of Radolfzell.

Day 4: Radolfzell – Engen – Tuttlingen – Mühlheim, approx. 40 km + train ride or approx. 60 km

You now turn your back on the lake and cycle past Langenstein Castle and the Aach spring, whose water mostly comes from the Danube. You are heading for Engen. We can recommend a train ride from here to Tuttlingen (not included) in order to avoid the incline involving some 500 metres of altitude. Along the Danube you roll - seemingly without effort - to Mühlheim.

Day 5: Mühlheim – Sigmaringen, approx. 50 km

At Beuron, you reach the Danube Gap, where the river breaks through the Swabian Alb and has formed some stunning countryside. Through the Danube valley, carved deep into the chalk rock, which rise some 200 m into the sky, you now pedal to Sigmaringen. The castle can be seen from afar. Today, it is still owned by the Princes of Hohenzollern-Sigmaringen.

Day 6: Sigmaringen – Bad Waldsee, approx. 65 km

Along the Danube you cycle to Hundersingen, where it's worth visiting the open air museum of Heuneburg. From here you head south for the Upper Swabian spa area with its many thermal springs. Today's destination is Bad Waldsee, mud spa and Kneipp spa resort with a Spätzle (German noodle) museum, where you can learn all about this favourite local dish.

Day 7: Bad Waldsee – Wangen im Allgäu, approx. 45 km

Today, you leave Upper Swabian for Allgäu and arrive in Wolfegg, where you can visit the extensive farmhouse museum. Via Kisslegg, you cycle on to Wangen in Allgäu with unspoiled city towers, many fountains and Baroque-style pub signs.

Day 8: Wangen im Allgäu – Constance, approx. 55 km + catamaran trip

You cycle along the Danube-Lake Constance-cycle path today, through the Tettang hops area, the most southern hops-growing area in Germany. Pedaling through orchards, you cycle to Kressbronn, where you find yourself back on Lake Constance. Following the Lake Constance cycle path, your tour takes you finally to Friedrichshafen, where you hop on to a catamaran to be returned to Constance.

Day 9: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast, you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
