### Itinerary

#### Your tour:

From Interlaken on Lake Thun, you follow the Aare and Rhine rivers to Lake Constance. You will enjoy cycling against a backdrop of Jungfrau, Mönch and Eiger, the capital city of Berne and the many small towns and villages on the edge of the Jura mountains with their definitive French flair and similarly the Rhine Falls and the southern flair of Lake Constance.

#### Day 1: Individual arrival in Interlaken

The town between Brienz and Thun Lakes is a popular start for a tour of the Aare ravine the mountain-scape of the Bernese Uplands. A breath-taking panorama of mountains awaits you - with views of the Jungfrau, Mönch and Eiger mountains - which are best seen from a trip on a rack-and-pinion train.

#### Day 2: Interlaken – Thun – Bern, approx. 35 km + boat trip

You start the day with a pleasant boat-ride across Thun Lake. Sit back and relax and watch the countryside slowly passing by. From Thun, you cycle to Berne, a simple route and well suited for acclimatizing to the days to come. Goethe thought Berne to be Switzerland's most beautiful town. Today, the old part of the town is world heritage site.

#### Day 3: Bern - Biel, approx. 50 km

You cycle along the banks of the Aare and Wohlensee Lake to the bilingual town of Biel/Bienne. The Swiss clock-making industry made this town famous. In the Omega museum you can find out more. Discover the many fountains the town has, which are mostly fed by Roman wells.

#### Day 4: Biel - Solothurn, approx. 35 km

Today's route is short so that you have enough time to spend in the old town or on the lake at the beach. Solothurn is the capital of the canton of the same name and is considered to be Switzerland's most beautiful Baroque town. The number eleven has particular significance here: there are 11 churches and chapels, 11 fountains, 11 towers and 11 steps.

#### Day 5: Solothurn – Aarau, approx. 55 km

The River Aare, which has by now increased considerably in size, is what shapes the landscape here. Villages, fields and a magnificent castle are on your way to Aarau, which still bears features dating back to the 16th century and from when the town was once the capital of the Helvetic Republic. Walk through the town - and keep looking up! This town is famous for its lovely gables. Be inspired by their painted scenes.

#### Day 6: Aarau – Waldshut-Tiengen, approx. 45 / 50 km

You cycle along the Aare to Brugg, where you should visit Habsburg Castle. The castle is the seat of the dynasty of the same name which once achieved the position of a true world power. Passing the "water castle" through which about half of the volume of Switzerland's water flows, you cycle on, via Koblenz, to where the Aare flows into the Rhine. The last section takes you to Waldshut-Tiengen.

#### Day 7: Waldshut-Tiengen – Schaffhausen, approx. 60 / 65 km

You cycle up the Rhine, passing Rheinau Abbey, which is situated idyllically on an island in the river. The closer you get to the Rhine Falls in Schaffhausen the louder the roar of the water gets. Try out one of the boat trips that take you to the rocks of the Falls and experience the roaring mass of water all around you.

#### Day 8: Schaffhausen - Constance, approx. 55 km

In the morning, enjoy a stroll through the canton's capital, watched over by Munot fort. And admire the gables - the citizens of the town competed with each other in building gables on their houses. Now, continue cycling upstream to Stein am Rhein, where town square is surrounded by frescoed houses. A good place for a break. Next, you follow the southern bank of Lake Constance, passing pretty fishing villages, to Constance. The old diocesan town was the site for the only Council to elect a pope north of the Alps in the Middle Ages.

#### Day 9: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast, you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.

#### Arrival in Interlaken

- → Closest airports: Zurich, Geneva, Basel-Mulhouse, Berne
- → Train station: Interlaken-West

#### Parking in Interlaken

- → Public car parks, costs approx. 20 30 CHF / day
- → Alternative: Parking in Constance

Costs 45 EUR / car, must be stated with the booking.

#### Return transfer to Interlaken

- → Optionally by chartered minibus, Saturdays and Sundays, duration approx. 2.5 hours, incl. bike. Must be booked in advance.
- → Alternatively self-organised by train, connections half-hourly, duration approx. 3.5 4 hours, 1 4 train changes, bikes must be booked in advance.
