# Itinerary / Services

## Your tour

Your motor yacht takes you from island to island. On the way you'll discover remote bays - perfect for diving into the Mediterranean straight from the boat. On your bike you will explore the winding route of the South Dalmatian coast, the famous Dubrovnik and the most beautiful beach of Croatia: Zlatni Rat, "the Golden Cape".

## Day 1: Individual arrival in Trogir, Trogir – Bračisland (boat), Bike tour Bračisland, approx. 25 km / 640 altitude difference

You go on board between 12:00 and 14:00 in Trogir. At a "Welcome-Aboard" drink hosted by your tour guide, you are invited to a small snack before setting off during the afternoon to the island of Brač. There, you will go off on a small bike tour from Supetar to Pučišća.

## Day 2: Brač island – Korčula island (boat), bike tour Korčula island approx. 35 km / 680 altitude difference

Right after breakfast, the boat casts off for the island of Korčula. It is known as the black island because of the pinewoods here. From the harbour in Račišće you cycle via Kneža and Žrnovska Banja to Korčula. Via Pupnat and Kneža you go back on board the boat and then set off back to Korčula where you spend the night.

## Day 3: Korčula island – Mljet island (boat), bike tour Mljet island, approx. 30 km / 910 altitude difference, Mljet island – Elaphiti islands (boat)

Enjoy your morning on board the boat as you sail over to the island of Mljet. From Sobra, you cycle through the island's forests via Prožura to Saplunara. After lunch and a break for a swim you cycle back to Sobra. From there you set sail again. Target today is: the Elafiti island of Šipan.

## Day 4: Bike tour Šipan island, approx. 10 km / 200 altitude difference, Šipan island – Dubrovnik (boat)

Today starts with a short cycle over the island of Šipan, from Šipanska Luka to Suđurađ and back. On board your boat, you sail to Dubrovnik, arriving around lunchtime. After lunch on board, you can go on a guided tour of the town. After the tour there is plenty of time to get to know the UNESCO World Heritage town.

#### Day 5: Dubrovnik – Pelješac peninsula (boat), Prapratno – Trstenik, approx. 35 km / 700 altitude difference

In the morning you set sail for Prapratno on the Pelješac peninsula. You hop onto your bike and cycle to Ston and Mali Ston, two places connected by a 5.5 km long wall. Via Dubrava and Žuljana you cycle to Trstenik, where your boat awaits you to take you to Kućište.

## Day 6: Pelješac peninsula – Hvar island (boat), bike tour Hvar island, approx. 40 km / 860 altitude difference

First the boat takes you to Hvar. From here, you cycle through fields of lavender and vineyards to Stari Grad, the oldest settlement on the island. In Stari Grad, lunch is served on board, then you set off for the second part of your cycle tour, a circular tour via Vrboska and Jelsa. You stay the night in the harbour at Stari Grad.

## Day 7: Hvar island – Insel Šolta (boat), bike tour Šolta island, approx. 20 km / 300 altitude difference, Šolta island – Trogir (boat)

During the two-hour boat trip from Stari Grad to Stomorska on the island of Šolta simply enjoy the beautiful countryside passing by. You cycle from Stomorska to Maslinica through lovely unspoiled villages. After lunch and a last swim, the boat takes yo back to Trogir.

#### Day 8: Individual departure

Disembarkation is after breakfast until 09.00. Then you set off on your individual journey home or get your transfer to the airport.

## Parking in Trogir

→ Monitored parking in Trogir, cost approx. EUR 50 per week. Parking spaces have to be reserved in advance and paid for on site (in Croatian Kuna).

## Mandatory helmets

- → On bicycle tours in Croatia helmets are mandatory for children under 18 years of age. However, for safety reasons we generally recommend wearing a helmet.
- → If you book a rental bike a rental helmet is included in the price, please state your head size upon booking. For an optimum fit we recommend that you bring your own helmet.

## Changes

→ Changes to boat trips due to weather, water levels or technical conditions are possible; the right to change is reserved.

# The boats



## MS Aneta, Standard

- Technical data
- → Length: 32 m
- → Width 6,50 m
- → Max. passengers: 32
- → 15 cabins (approx. 4 5 m<sup>2</sup>), all with shower/WC, the corridor on the lower deck has air-conditioning.

The MS Aneta was built in 1958 and completely renovated in 2009. The ship offers a saloon, a 150 m<sup>2</sup> sun deck with 15 deck chairs for relaxing, as well as tables and chairs for 20 people.

The lower deck houses 2 3-bed cabins with a double bed and a single bunk bed above. The main deck (above deck) offers 13 double cabins with bunk beds. Some of the windows in the cabins can be opened.



## MS Orkan, Standard

- Technical data
- → Length: 20 m
- → Width: 6 m
- → Max. passengers: 20
- → 10 cabins (approx. 4 5 m<sup>2</sup>), all with shower/WC, the corridor on the lower deck has air-conditioning.

The MS Orkan was built in 1928 and was completely restored in 2006. The boat offers an air-conditioned saloon, a 60 m<sup>2</sup> sun deck with 12 sun loungers for relaxation, as well as tables and benches on deck with room for 18 people. The lower deck offers 4 double cabins with a double bed, as well as one double cabin with bunk beds. On the main deck (= above deck) there are three double cabins with bunk beds. On the upper deck<sup>1</sup> there are two double cabins with bunk beds. Some of the windows in the cabins can be opened.

<sup>1</sup>The upper deck corresponds to the main deck in the pricing table. Cabins are distributed on-site.



# The boats



## MY Relax, Deluxe

- Technical data
- → Length: 46 m
- → Width: 8,50 m
- → Max. passengers: 40
- → 19 cabins (approx. 12 m<sup>2</sup>), all with shower/WC and individually regulated air-conditioning.

The MY Relax had its maiden voyage in 2018. It was constructed in the style of a motor yacht and is perfectly suited to the needs of bicycle travellers. At the rear of the boat there is a bathing platform with showers. The air-conditioned saloon offers space for up to 40 guests. The lounge area has cosy seating areas. The 220 m<sup>2</sup> sun deck has sun loungers for all guests, so that everyone can relax in the sunshine. The upper deck can be covered with tarpaulin if required.

The lower deck offers 4 double cabins with twin beds, 2 double cabins with a double bed, as well as 2 3-bed cabins with a double bed and a single bed next to it. The main deck has 6 double cabins with twin beds, as well as 5 double cabins with a double bed. The cabins on the lower deck have portholes that can't be opened. The windows in the cabins on the main deck can be opened.
