# Itinerary / services

## Your tour

Discover the small, hidden bays and idyllic fishing villages on this tour. Dive into the glass clear water and relax on the sundeck. By bike you cycle through scented forests and frequently have the wide expanse of the sea and numerous islands in your view. If you like you can spend half or whole days on board, swimming, relaxing and sunbathing.

### Day 1: Individual arrival in Zadar, Zadar – Vir, approx. 30 km / 200 m altitude difference

Embarkation between 11.30 and 13.00 in Zadar. You are welcomed on board by the tour guide with drinks and a snack. Your first bike trip is in the afternoon. It takes you through Kožino, Petrčane and Zaton to Nin and over a bridge to Vir, on the island of the same name.

### Day 2: Vir – Molat island (boat), round tour on Molat island, approx. 20 km / 250 m altitude difference, Molat island – Zverinac island (boat)

In the morning, relax on the boat as it takes you to the island of Molat. In Molat, you get back on your bike and cycle to Zapuntel and back. In the afternoon you sail by boat to the island of Zverinac.

### Day 3: Zverinac island – Dugi Otok island (boat), round tour on Dugi Otok island, approx. 30 km / 530 m altitude difference

First, you go by boat to Božava on the island of Dugi Otok. Today's cycle ride takes you to the lighthouse of Veli Rat and then on via Verunić, Božava and Dragove to Brbinj. Finally, the boat takes you to the Sali, the main town on Dugi Otok island.

### Day 4: Round tour on Dugi Otok island, approx. 10 km / 200 m altitude difference, Dugi Otok island – Kornati islands – Šibenik (boat)

After breakfast, you cycle to Telašćica Nature Park, where you walk to a salt water lake and impressive cliffs. You have lunch on board and the boat takes course for the Kornati Islands National Park. After about 4 to 5 hours you reach Šibenik.

### Day 5: Šibenik – Skradin (boat), bike tour to Krka, approx. 10 km / 300 m altitude difference, Skradin – Martinska (boat), Martinska – Vodice, approx. 10 km / 100 m altitude difference

First, the boat takes you along Krka river to Skradin. Today, the short cycle tour begins to the famous Krka waterfalls. The river falls over a distance of 800 m through 17 waterfalls down 46 m into the deep. Back in Skradin you go on board and leave for the harbour of Martinska. From there, you cycle to the place where you stay the night – Vodice.

### Day 6: Vodice – Murter island, approx. 30 km / 270 m altitude difference

The day begins with a great cycle tour! You'll get to know a section of the coast first, with lots of pretty islands. You soon reach a viewing point, known as "Okit". Via Tribunj and Sovlje you continue on to Tisno. Crossing a bridge you cycle on to the island of Murter and from there via Lovišća, Plitka Vala, Betina and Murter to the bay of Podvrške.

### Day 7: Murter Island – Pašman island (by boat), bike tour on Pasman and Ugljan islands, approx. 30 km / 290 m altitude difference, Ugljan island – Zadar (by boat)

During breakfast on board, you are taken to Tkon on the island of Pašman. Here you hop on to your bike and cycle from Tkon via Pašman, Neviđane, Dobropoljana and Ždrelac to the bridge that connects the two islands of Pašman and Ugljan. You continue on via Kali to Preko. In the afternoon the boat takes you back to Zadar.

### Day 8: Individual departure

Disembarkation is after breakfast until 09.00. Then you set off on your individual journey home or get your transfer to the airport.

## Arrival in Zadar

- Zadar airport:  
A transfer can be booked from the airport to the boat and back upon request and provision of the flight number and arrival time. The price for the transfer will be determined and communicated at the beginning of 2021.

## Parking in Zadar

- Monitored parking in Zadar, cost approx. EUR 55 per week.  
Parking spaces have to be reserved in advance and paid for on site (in Croatian Kuna).

## Mandatory helmets

- On bicycle tours in Croatia helmets are mandatory for children under 18 years of age. However, for safety reasons we generally recommend wearing a helmet.
- If you book a rental bike a rental helmet is included in the price, please state your head size upon booking. For an optimum fit we recommend that you bring your own helmet.

## Changes

- Changes to boat trips due to weather, water levels or technical conditions are possible; the right to change is reserved.

# The boats



## MS Dalmatino, Standard

Technical data

- Length: 26 m
- Width: 6,50 m
- Max. passengers: 26

- 13 cabins (approx. 4 – 5 m<sup>2</sup>), all with shower/WC and individually regulated air-conditioning.

The motor sailing boat Dalmatino was built in 1957 and fully rebuilt in 1990. You can look forward to an air-conditioned saloon and a generous 90 m<sup>2</sup> sun deck with 10 sun loungers. There are also tables and benches on deck, with seating for approximately 20 people.

On the main deck (= above deck) there are 8 double cabins with bunk beds. On the upper deck<sup>1</sup> there are 5 double cabins with bunk beds. This boat offers no 3-bed cabins. The cabins have portholes that can be opened.

## MS Kazimir, Standard

Technical data

- Length: 39 m
- Width: 7 m
- Max. passengers: 38

- 16 cabins (approx. 9 m<sup>2</sup>), all with shower/WC and individually regulated air-conditioning.

The motor sailing boat MS Kazimir was first built in 1946 and completely remodelled in 1999/2000. All superstructures were removed and boat's hull was remodelled to make space for everything that Boat and Bike travellers desire. It was renovated once again between 2016 and 2019, so everything is state-of-the-art.

The MS Kazimir offers a 150 m<sup>2</sup> sun deck with deck chairs, as well as tables and chairs. The air-conditioned saloon offers space for 38 people.

All cabins are located on the main deck and the upper deck<sup>1</sup>. There are no cabins below deck. The main deck offers 6 cabins with a double bed and a single bunk bed above, as well as 2 double cabins with a double bed. The upper deck<sup>1</sup> offers 4 double cabins with bunk beds and 4 double cabins with a double bed. The portholes and windows on the main and upper deck can be opened.

# The boats



## MS Carpe Diem, Premium

Technical data

- Length: 40 m
- Width: 8,30 m
- Max. passengers: 34

- 18 cabins (approx. 8 – 10 m<sup>2</sup>), all with shower/WC and individually regulated air-conditioning.

The MS Carpe Diem was built in 2015/2016 and had its maiden voyage in spring 2016. The comfortable motor sailing boat offers an air-conditioned saloon, a 250 m<sup>2</sup> sun deck with 20 deck chairs, tables, benches and chairs on the covered upper deck, as well as a bathing platform with showers at the rear of the boat. There is an area for bike storage on the main deck. The lower deck offers 1 3-bed cabin with a double bed and a single bed next to it, as well as 7 double cabins with a double bed. On the main deck (above deck) there are 5 double cabins with twin beds and 4 double cabins with a double bed. The cabins on the lower deck have portholes, which can't be opened. The cabins on the main deck have windows, which can be opened.

## MY Voyage\*, Deluxe

Technical data

- Length: 40 m
- Width: 8,50 m
- Max. passengers: 38

- 18 cabins (approx. 11 m<sup>2</sup>), all with shower/WC and individually regulated air-conditioning.

The motor yacht Voyage\* will be completed in time for the summer season 2020 and is perfectly suited to the needs of Bike and Boat travellers who don't want to miss out on the comfort of a hotel room. The boat is expected to offer a 250 m<sup>2</sup> sun deck with sun loungers, a bathing platform with showers, as well as an air-conditioned saloon and a lounge area with 38 seats each. The upper deck can be covered with tarpaulin if required.

The lower deck offers 6 double cabins with twin or single beds, as well as 2 3-bed cabins with a double bed and a single bed next to it. There are 10 double cabins with twin beds or a double bed on the main deck. Portholes supply light in the cabins on the lower deck, however, it is expected that these can't be opened. The cabins on the main deck will be fitted with windows, which most likely can be opened. Layouts and interior design won't be finalised until the boat is completed.
