Itinerary

Your tour

Are you looking for a challenging cycle holiday, but also want to spend your holiday at the beach and swimming in the sea? This bike & boat tour in the south of Croatia might just be the right one for you! By bike and boat you discover the small islands, lonely beaches with crystal clear water and fascinating landscapes. The highlight of this tour: A rafting tour through Cetina-Canyon on day 6.

Day 1: Individual arrival in Trogir, Trogir –Šolta Island (boat), bike tour on Šolta Island, approx. 20 km

The MS Orkan awaits you in the harbour of Trogir for boarding between 12.00 and 14.00. While you enjoy a first snack on board, the boat enters the sea and steers towards Maslinica on the Šolta Island. Your first bike trip leads you through old little villages, just like Gornje Selo, where you visit an olive oil mill and can taste the local specialty! Your bike tour takes you through Grohote to Stomorska, where you will have dinner on board.

Day 2: Šolta Island –Brač Island (boat), bike tour on Brač Island, approx. 45 / 55 km

Your day starts with a one-hour boat trip to Milna on Brač Island. Back on the bike you cycle towards the famous beach in Bol. If you haven't had enough after approximately 500 m in altitude difference on the bike, you can take a detour to the top of Vidova Gora, the highest mountain on the Croatian Islands with 778 m. Your destination is Bol and the "Golden Horn", Zlatni Rat, one of the most beautiful beaches on the Mediterranean Sea.

Day 3: Brač Island –Vis Island (boat), bike tour on Vis Island, approx. 35 km

After breakfast your boat takes you to the Island of Vis. Only since the 1990s foreigners can step foot on the island, it was highly forbidden before. In earlier times there was a military base, nowadays there are olive trees and farms. Discover the nearly untouched nature on the hilly island by bike. Leaving the harbour, you cycle through Dračevo Polje to Komiža. Take your time to enjoy lunch, before you cycle back to the city of Vis.

4. Tag: Vis Island –Korčula Island (boat), bike tour on Korčula Island, approx. 50 km

Your day starts with a three-hours boat trip to Korčula Island. After you reach the bay of Vela Luka in the west of the island, you take your bike and cycle to the city of Korčula in the southeast of the island. You cycle through deep forests of pine and oak trees, which cover more than half of the island. You avoid the biggest climb today by taking the small roads around. You spend the night in the city of Korčula.

Day 5: Korčula Island – Hvar Island (boat), bike tour Hvar Island, approx. 50 km, Hvar Island – Brač Island (boat)

Your first destination is the island of Hvar. Leaving Sućuraj, you cycle through beautiful vineyards and olive groves to the relaxing village Jelsa. During dinner, the MS Orkan sets course to Brač Island. Before your swimming hotel banks in the harbour of Postira or Pučišća, you should take advantage of the short break and jump into the Mediterranean Sea. Look forward to the Captain's Dinner, which is on the agenda for tonight.

Day 6: Brač Island – Omiš (boat), bike tour approx. 25 km and Rafting tour or bike tour approx. 40 km, Omiš – Split (boat)

After entering the harbour of Omiš, you cycle along the river Cetina through the almost untouched nature of the fascinating Cetina Canyon. In Pavića Most you trade your bike in for a small rafting boat and hop on the river Cetina! If you don't feel like rafting today, you can just cycle back to the boat. After lunch on board of MS Orkan, your boat leaves the harbour and sets course towards Split. A guided tour through the city awaits you!

Day 7: Bike tour around Split, approx. 20 km, Split – Trogir (boat)

After breakfast, you cycle towards Marjan Mountain, not far away of Split. Afterwards, your lunch on boards awaits you and your boat slowly brings you to Trogir, your final destination. In Trogir you can spend the rest of the day sightseeing. There is a guided tour, which teaches you a lot about the history of the town, before you have dinner in a local restaurant.

Day 8: Individual departure

Disembarkation is after breakfast until 09.00. Then you set off on your individual journey home or get your transfer to the airport.

The boat



MS Orkan, Standard

Technical data

- Length: 20 m
- Width: 6 m
- Max. passengers: 20

- 10 cabins (approx. 4 – 5 m²), all with shower/WC, the corridor on the lower deck has air-conditioning.

The MS Orkan was built in 1928 and was completely restored in 2006. The boat offers an air-conditioned saloon, a 60 m² sun deck with 12 sun loungers for relaxation, as well as tables and benches on deck with room for 18 people. The lower deck offers 4 double cabins with a double bed, as well as one double cabin with bunk beds. On the main deck (= above deck) there are three double cabins with bunk beds. On the upper deck¹ there are two double cabins with bunk beds. Some of the windows in the cabins can be opened.

¹The upper deck corresponds to the main deck in the pricing table. Cabins are distributed on-site.
