Itinerary / services

Your tour:

In the turquoise water of the Mediterranean, you sail to the islands of Krk, Rab and Cres in Kvarner Bay. You cycle via hidden paths to remote bays and get to know the historic town centres and harbour cities. On board, cool down with a short jump into the waves and enjoy the rays of the Mediterranean sun on the sun deck.

Day 1: Individual arrival in Rijeka, Rijeka – Krk island (boat), bike tour Krk island, approx. 35 km

Embarkation between 11.00 and 12.00 in Rijeka. You are welcomed by the tour guide with drinks and a snack. In the afternoon, your boat takes you to Krk, where you set off on your first bike tour. From Njivice you take a round trip to Krk town, the main town on the island.

Day 2: Bike tour Krk island, approx. 35 km

Today begins with a cycle trip inland to Dobrinj and on to the pretty historic town of Vrbnik, which is located far up above on a rock. The uphill climb will be rewarded with a grande view. After lunch, you cycle on towards Krk town, where your boat awaits you.

Day 3: Krk island – Rab island (boat), bike tour Rab island, approx. 20 km

You start the day with a boat trip to Lopar in the north of the island of Rab. The bike tour begins here and takes you via Supetarska Draga and Kapor to Rab with its four bell towers. After lunch you visit the forest park Kalifront. During the guided tour in Rab in the evening you will pass some nice restaurants – choose one of them for dinner.

Day 4: Rab island – Pag island (boat), bike tour Pag island, approx. 35 km

By boat you sail to Lun at the northern point of the island of Pag, an island full of contradictions: scraggy countryside, lush green meadows, dotted with sheep. In the morning, you go on a bike tour to Novalja and in the afternoon, you cycle via Kolan to Mandre where the boat is waiting for you.

Day 5: Pag island – Lošinj island (boat), bike tour Lošinj island, approx. 20 km

Enjoy the sun and the passing scenery on your four-hour crossing to Mali Lošinj on the island of Lošinj. The bike tour takes you through extensive pine forests round the Čikat bay and through the Sunčana Uvala (sun bay) to Veli Lošinj. It's only a few more kilometres back to Mali Lošinj, where you stay overnight.

Day 6: Bike tour Lošinj island – Cres island, approx. 45 km, Martinšćica – Cres (boat)

Today you'll get to know two islands - thanks to the lifting bridge you can bike from Lošinj to Osor on the island of Cres. You continue on via Belej and Stivan on to the bay of Martinšćica. From there, the boat takes you to Cres town, where you stay overnight.

Day 7: Bike tour Cres island, approx. 30 km, Cres island – Rijeka (boat)

The last bike trip on this tour takes you from Cres town to a viewing point at the village of Predošćica. Have a last gaze at this unique countryside before you cycle back to the boat to sail to Rijeka. On the way, enjoy a last hop into the wonderful waves of the Adriatic.

Day 8: Individual departure

Disembarkation is after breakfast until 09.00. Then you set off on your individual journey home or get your transfer to the airport.

Arrival in Rijeka

- Rijeka airport:
A transfer can be booked from the airport to the boat and back upon request and provision of the flight number and arrival time. The price for the transfer will be determined and communicated at the beginning of 2021.

Parking in Rijeka

- Monitored parking in Rijeka, cost approx. EUR 55 per week.
Parking spaces have to be reserved in advance and paid for on site (in Croatian Kuna).

Mandatory helmets

- On bicycle tours in Croatia helmets are mandatory for children under 18 years of age. However, for safety reasons we generally recommend wearing a helmet.
- If you book a rental bike a rental helmet is included in the price, please state your head size upon booking.
For an optimum fit we recommend that you bring your own helmet.

Changes

- Changes to boat trips due to weather, water levels or technical conditions are possible; the right to change is reserved.

Boat descriptions



MS Planka, Standard

Technical data

- Length: 27,30 m
- Width: 6,20 m
- Max. passengers: 24

- 11 cabins (approx. 5 m²), all with shower/WC and individually regulated air-conditioning.

The MS Planka was built in 1957 and was fully reconstructed in 2005. It offers an air-conditioned saloon, a 100 m² sun deck with 10 sun loungers, as well as tables and benches on deck for approximately 14 people.

The lower deck offers 4 3-bed cabins with a double bed and a third bed above. On the main deck (= above deck) there are 3 double cabins with bunk beds. The upper deck¹ has 4 double cabins with a double bed. The portholes in the cabins on the main and upper deck can be opened. The cabins on the lower deck have a ventilation system.

¹The upper deck corresponds to the main deck in the pricing table. Cabins are distributed on-site.



MS Kapetan Kuka, Standard

Technical data

- Length: 36 m
- Width: 8 m
- Max. passengers: 34

- 14 cabins (approx. 7 – 8 m²), all with shower/WC and individually regulated air-conditioning.

The MS Kapetan Kuka was built in 1989 and renovated in 2016. It offers an air-conditioned saloon for 34 people, a 150 m² sun deck with deck chairs and seating areas (the sun deck is partly covered), as well as tables and benches for approximately 15 – 20 people on the covered main deck. At the rear of the boat there is a bathing platform with showers.

On the lower deck you will find 6 double cabins with bunk beds and 4 3-bed cabins with a double bed and a bunk bed above. On the main deck (above deck) there is 1 double cabin with bunk beds, as well as 1 family cabin (two double cabins with shared shower/WC, there is a shared private entrance area to these cabins). On the upper deck¹ there are 2 double cabins with bunk beds.

Boat descriptions



MS Aria, Premium

Technical data

- Length: 43,50 m
- Width: 8,50 m
- Max. passengers: 40

- 18 cabins (approx. 9 – 13 m²), all with shower/WC and individually regulated air-conditioning.

The motor sailing boat Aria was built in 2015/2016 and had its maiden voyage in spring 2016. It offers an air-conditioned saloon, a 250 m² sun deck with sun loungers, tables, benches and chairs on the covered main deck, as well as a bathing platform with showers at the rear of the boat.

There are 2 3-bed cabins on the lower deck, which are fitted with two twin beds and a third bunk bed above; 2 double cabins with twin beds that can be pushed together as a double bed, and four double cabins with a double bed. On the main deck (= above deck) there are six double cabins with a double bed. On the upper deck¹ there are four double cabins with twin beds, which can be pushed together as a double bed. The portholes in the cabins on the main and upper deck can be opened. The cabins on the lower deck have a ventilation system that ensures a flow of fresh air despite the fact that the portholes can't be opened.

MY Alpha*, Deluxe

Technical data

- Length: 48,50 m
- Width: 8,50 m
- Max. passengers: 40

- 19 cabins (approx. 11 m²), all with shower/WC, TV and individually regulated air-conditioning.

The MY Alpha* will be completed in summer 2020 and is perfectly geared towards Bike and Boat travellers who don't want to miss the comfort of a hotel room during their journey. The boat, which is built in the style of a motor yacht, will offer a 270 m² sun deck with sun loungers, a bathing platform with showers, a Jacuzzi, as well as an air-conditioned saloon and lounge area, both with 40 seats.

The lower deck houses 6 double cabins with twin beds or a double bed, as well as 2 3-bed cabins with a double bed and a single bed. There are 11 double cabins with twin beds or a double bed on the main deck. It is expected that the cabins will have twin beds that can be pushed together as a double bed. However, the interior design won't be finalised until the boat is completed.
