Itinerary

Your tour:

On this more athletic tour, you can look forward to dunes, great sandy beaches, cliffs and the coastal resort architecture so typical of the Baltic Coast. You cycle over 550 km along the coast and on Rügen. The focus of this tour is on cycling. This tour is suitable for people who enjoy cycling and are not put off by longer stretches in the saddle. Enjoy beautiful views of the Baltic Sea, the well-known chalk cliffs on Rügen and the old Hanseatic towns.

Day 1: Individual arrival in Lübeck

This cycle tour along the Baltic Coast starts in an old and gracious Hanseatic town that was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987. People will know you are talking about Lübeck if you mention the Holsten Gate, marzipan and Thomas Mann. Bite into a yummy fish roll to start your holiday mood!

Day 2: Lübeck – Wismar, approx. 80 km + ferry trip (not included)

You continue along the coast, through Brooker Wald nature reserve to Boltenhagen, where you have views of the entire bay from the cliffs. You continue, mostly along the coast, to the old Hanseatic town of Wismar. From here we recommend a short trip to Poel island to explore its long sandy beaches and go for a swim.

Day 3: Wismar – Rostock, approx. 90 km

On the way to Kühlungsborn, cliffs and beautiful beaches alternate along your path, offering great views or great swimming. Just before Nienhagen is the "haunted forest" - a mixed forest of trees that have taken weird and wonderful shapes because of the age-old influence of the salty, moist sea air and the stormy winds. You cycle to Rostock via Warnemünde.

Day 4: Rostock – Zingst/ Barth, approx. 75/ 90 km + ferry trip (not included)

Via Warnemünde you cycle to Wustrow, on the Fischland-Darss peninsular, the former border between Mecklenburg and Pommern. Discover Darss woods and the romantic of the wild west beach, which is considered to be one of the most beautiful beaches in the world. Via Zingst you cycle back to the mainland, to the former Swedish town of Barth.

Day 5: Zingst/ Barth – Stralsund, approx. 65/ 50 km

Look forward to this section of your tour: the three towers of the Hanseatic town of Stralsund beckon from afar. Its former importance as a trading town can still be seen in the historic quarter today. Let your evening come to a pleasant close here; because the old quarter has been so beautifully preserved, it is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Day 6: Stralsund – Ummanz – Breege / Glowe, approx. 100 / 115 km + ferry trip (not included)

You take the direct route today from Stralsund to Rügen island: first stop Ummanz island. The second largest Baltic Sea island in Germany. Back on the neighbouring island of Rügen you continue to the coastal resort of Vashvitz. A dreamy, quiet town to relax in. Alternatively, you can stay the night in Breege.

Day 7: Breege – Sellin / Göhren, approx. 80 / 65 km

You cycle to Sassnitz first today. The famous chalk cliffs north of the town should not be missed. The typical characteristics of the buildings on the Baltic Coast are classicist elements, woodcarvings and long sea piers, which whisk you back into the 19th century. In Sellin you can walk out into the sea along the almost 400-m long pier - before you pedal on to reach Göhren.

Day 8: Göhren – Stralsund, approx. 75 km

Today you'll cross the southern part of Rügen island at a pace. Take a break in Putbus and go for a walk through the 200-year-old castle park, which was landscaped according to French design. In Altfähr, you can already see the unmistakable silhouette of Stralsund.

Day 9: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast, you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
