Itinerary

Your tour:

On Germany's biggest island you'll find endless beaches, unspoiled nature and lovely seaside resorts. Racing Roland will get your children's hearts beating faster. The boat trip to Hiddensee Island is an adventure! Lovely sandy beaches and small fishing villages with thatched houses await you on the island.

Day 1: Individual arrival in Stralsund

The starting point of your cycle tour is the old Hanseatic town Stralsund, whose old town was declared a UNESCO World Heritage site because it has been so beautifully preserved. Its former importance as a trading town can still be seen today. Let your evening come to a pleasant end in the old town and wander across the harbour island.

Day 2: Day trip to Hiddensee Island

In the morning, you take the ferry to Hiddensee Island, where you go on a trip by bike to the 28-m high lighthouse called "Leuchtfeuer Dornbusch", or simply spend a day swimming at the beach. In the afternoon, a ferry takes you back to Stralsund.

Day 3: Stralsund - Putbus - Göhren, approx. 50 km + train ride

You cycle over Rügen's dam to the island and then on to Putbus. Racing Roland, a steam train, will get your children's hearts beating faster! With a huff and a puff, Rügen's bathers' train (max. speed 30 km/h!) takes you to Göhren, where you get to explore a beautiful sandy beach!

Day 4: Day on the beach or hiking on the Mönchgut peninsula

Mönchgut peninsula is surrounded by the Baltic Sea on three sides and is one of Rügen's wonderful secrets. The diverse countryside has a lot to offer. You can decide spontaneously what you feel like doing: a relaxed day swimming at the beach or a short walk through the dunes, over the heaths into the woods. No matter how you decide, you're sure to like it!

Day 5: Göhren - Sassnitz, approx. 35 km

In Sellin, you can walk out on to Rügen's longest pier - almost 400 metres - while in Binz, Rügen's biggest seaside resort is waiting for your visit. Take a little extra trip to Granitz Hunting Lodge or enjoy a picnic on Schmachter See Lake. In Prora, the impressive buildings here will amaze you, before you then pedal on along the coast to Sassnitz.

Day 6: Day trip to the chalk cliffs, boat trip (not included) or approx. 30 km

You cycle through beech woods, across moors and meadows in Jasmund national park, up to the famous chalk cliffs at Königsstuhl, where you have fantastic views. This cycle tour is short but tough. People who want to leave out the hills by bike should explore the famous cliff coast by boat (not included in price).

Day 7: Sassnitz - Bergen, approx. 25 km

Today you cycle to the centre of the island, to Rügen's biggest town. The path takes you between the smaller and larger Jasmund Bodden. Just before Bergen is Nonnensee Lake, a glacial meltwater lake from the Ice Age. You pedal round it and can do some bird-watching along the way. In Bergen, we recommend visiting Rugard. It is Bergen's highest point at 91 metres above sea level.

Day 8: Bergen – Putbus – Stralsund, train ride (not included) or approx. 55 km

Today you cycle via Putbus back to Stralsund. If you don't want to do this section again by bike, you can take a train from Bergen to Stralsund (not included in price). If you do the stretch by bike, take a break in Putbus and wander through the 200-year-old castle park, which is landscaped to French design. In Altefähr, you can already see the unmistakable silhouette of Stralsund.

Day 9: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast, you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
