Itinerary

Your tour:

The mud flats and the long sandy beach in St. Peter-Ording await you along the North Sea. The diverse Baltic Sea coast has something to offer for everyone, whether it is the Wind and water mills, the cliffs, or the interesting small towns. Most of your overnight stays will be in small charming towns consisting of the typical thatched roof houses that you can have a look at during walks. While you're there you should try well-known regional delicacies like Saure Rolle or Labskaus. Have a Pharisäer or a Küstennebel to go along with your food and you'll be ready for the next day in no time!

Day 1: Individual arrival in Husum

You won't find a better place to explore the North Sea coast than Husum. Even the changing of the tide is a sight to see. The town has grown a lot over the last few centuries and will not leave any wishes unfulfilled, culinary or cultural. Husum is definitely the perfect starting point for your cycling tour along the North Sea.

Day 2: Husum – Schleswig, approx. 45 km

After leaving the North Sea you start cycling along the Eider-Treene-Sorge path to Hollingstedt, where you can visit Northern Europe's largest archaeological monument that dates back to the Vikings: the Haithabu trading post and the Danewerk fortifications. Soon after that you will arrive in Schleswig, a lovely little town located directly on the banks of the Schlei. Here you should consider visiting Gottorf castle, the baroque garden, and the giant globe.

Day 3: Schleswig – Kappeln, approx. 50 km

Today the Schlei will accompany you on your trip. On your way from Schleswig to the North Sea you will pass many small and pretty villages, such as Arnis, the smallest town in Germany. Take a break here and enjoy the maritime flair of the town. A little further down the road you will arrive in Kappeln, where you can have a look at the largest Dutch windmill of state, the herring fence, and the museum harbour.

Day 4: Kappeln – Eckernförde, approx. 40 km

The Baltic Sea resort Damp is easily accessible via the peninsula Schwansen. There you can relax in a beach chair along the sandy 4 km beach. After your break you continue your journey through unspoilt nature, past old avenues, over gentle hills, and lush green forests to Eckernförde. Spend the evening at the beautiful and idyllic harbour promenade. Try the freshly caught fish in one of the cosy restaurants.

Day 5: Eckernförde – Rendsburg, approx. 40 / 75 km

Are your legs still in good shape? Then cycle along the coast towards Kiel. Shortly before you reach the capital of Schleswig-Holstein, the Kiel Canal flows into the sea. It is one of the most frequented waterways in the world. Alternatively, you can take the shortcut through the inland, crossing forests, fields and moors.

Day 6: Rendsburg – Friedrichstadt, approx. 50 km

Before you leave, go for a walk through the historic district of Rendsburg with its narrow streets, medieval squares and the old town hall. Once you are back on your bike, today's tour will lead you through breathtaking nature and small villages with thatched roofs, that will make you think that the time is standing still. Friedrichstadt is located between the Eider and Treene rivers.

Day 7: Friedrichstadt – St. Peter-Ording – Husum, approx. 55 km + train ride

Go on a leisurely stroll through Friedrichstadt, which is also called "Holländerstadt" (Dutch city) because of its numerous canals. On your way to Tönning you will pass the famous Hoyerswort manor house. After that you aren't far away from St. Peter-Ording and its 12 km long flat sandy beach. The dunes offer you an unforgettable view of the houses on stilts, the beach sailors and the sea.

Day 8: Individual departure or extension of stay

After breakfast, you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
